position because of "indications" that violence might erupt on the campus as a result of "the involvement of people outside the university," Hofstra University officials have reversed their previous position and ordered a neo-Nazi student, David Kerr, 20, to remove a Nazi flag from his dormitory window.

Kerr first flew the flag on Feb. 13, after placing two recruiting ads for the National Socialist White People's Party of Arlington, Va., in "The Chronicle," the student newspaper which is supported by student activity fees. When Jewish students and faculty members, and religious advisors at the university protested, university officials, backed by the Board of Trustees, defended Kerr's right to place the ads and fly the flag on the grounds of "freedom of speech."

University spokesman Gene Boneker said the officials changed their minds after a series of events which included a speech by Rabbi Meir Kahane, head of the Jewish Defense League,

Israelite Ads Pay

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- A full page anti-Israel advertisement in the New York Times headed "Israel: our next Vietnam?" which opposed American aid to Israel, used an out-of-context quotation of the late John F. Kennedy (before he became president) to suggest opposition to such aid, and listed in a box at the bottom of the ad the names of 14 Senators who "showed courage and foresight" by voting against Phantoms for Israel, has been denounced by the Senators listed who say they knew nothing about the ad before it appeared in the newspaper. The ad was signed by Alfred M. Lilienthal, a noted, veteran Jewish anti-Zionist who heads the New York-based Middle East Perspective. It is not known who paid

A spokesman for Sen. Edward M. Kennedy (D., Mass.) criticized the use of the out-of-context quotation saying, "It was incorrect to suggest he opposed aid to Israel. It misconstrues the position of President Kennedy, who is clearly on record as favoring aid to Israel." Two Senators, Philip A. Hart (D., Mich.) and Margaret Chase Smith (R., Me.) criticized the use of their names in the ad with its implication of an anti-Israel stance. Both stated they had always been supporters of Israel and had voted against a Nov. 23 amendment to authorize \$500 million in military credits to Israel--half of it for Phantoms -- on procedural grounds since the money had already been provided for in previous bills.

### The Missing Link

The last remaining link to be forged in the Howard Hughes amazing "autobiography hoax," is disclosure of the person or persons who supplied the information to phoney author Clifford Irving.

From facts, not yet made public, to be turned into circumstantial evidence in the near future, the ugly finger of suspicion is being pointed at, you guessed it, Las Vegas Sun publisher Hank Greenspun.

Sounds incredible, doesn't it? But the known circumstances, which until recently, had provided all the necessary components, except one, for the punishable crime of conspiracy, have since completed the cycle in the chain of accusation. All that remains is the full coordination of the assembled facts, and the possible break-down of author Irving, who has admitted his guilt and is pleading to "tell all" in return for a deal that would absolve his wife.

Where does Greenspun fit into this bizarre hoax, which could have been pulled off, had not McGraw-Hill on Dec. 7, publicly released the story of the publication of the Hughes "autobiography?" On that date, James Phelan, described as Sun investigative reporter (whatever that is), was in Hank Greenspun's office in the Las Vegas Sun. Not a peep was issued at that time concerning Phelan and his association with the Hughes hoax by Irving.

However, on Feb. 13, a full week later, a Sun page 1 headline blazened with: "SUN WRITER BARES IRVING HOAX."

It appears that Phelan had been working for more than a year on a Hughes book for Noah Dietrich, who had been a long-time, long ago top executive for the billionaire. According to Phelan, the Irving hoax "autobiography" was a re-write of, "in scores of places," from the manuscript prepared by Phelan for Dietrich.

Thus, with the association of Phelan and Greenspun, is established the probability of Greenspun, as one of the few persons in this world who had access to the Phelan manuscript, which wound up in Irving's hands.

Even more binding on this point is a comprehensive column by Greenspun, reviewing all the passages discrediting Hughes in a Noah Dietrich book by Hollywood newspaperman Bob Thomas. It is significant to note that Greenspun makes no mention in his review of Phelan (his own reporter) who has been dumped, apparently, in the maze of circumstances evolving on the
