The last remaining link to be forged in the Howard Hughes amazing "autobiography hoax," is disclosure of the person or persons who supplied the information to phoney author Clifford Irving.

From facts, not yet made public, to be turned into circumstantial evidence in the near future, the ugly finger of suspicion is being

pointed at, you guessed it, Las Vegas Sun publisher Hank Greenspun. Sounds incredible, doesn't it? But the known circumstances, which until recently, had provided all the necessary components, except one, for the punishable crime of conspiracy, have since completed the cycle in the chain of accusation. All that remains is the full coordination of the assembled facts, and the possible break-down of author Irving, who has admitted his guilt and is pleading to "tell all" in return for a deal that would absolve his

Where does Greenspun fit into this bizarre hoax, which could have been pulled off, had not McGraw-Hill on Dec. 7, publicly released the story of the publication of the Hughes "autobiography?" On that date, James Phelan, described as Sun investigative reporter (whatever that is), was in Hank Greenspun's office in the Las Vegas Sun. Not a peep was issued at that time concerning Phelan and his association with the Hughes hoax by Irving.

However, on Feb. 13, a full week later, a Sun page I headline blazened with: "SUN WRITER BARES IRVING HOAX." with: "SUN

It appears that Phelan had been working for more than a year on a Hughes book for Noah Dietrich, who had been a long-time, long ago top executive for the billionaire. According to Phelan, the Irving hoax "autobiography" was a re-write of, "in scores of places," from the manuscript prepared by Phelan for Dietrich.

Thus, with the association of Phelan and Greenspun, is established the probability of Greenspun, as one of the few persons in this world who had access to the Phelan manu-

script, which wound up in Irving's hands.
Even more binding on this point is a
comprehensive column by Greenspun, reviewing all the passages discrediting Hughes in a Noah Dietrich book by Hollywood newspaperman Bob Thomas. It is significant to note that Greenspun makes no mention in his review of Phelan (his own reporter) who has been dumped, apparently, in the maze of circumstances evolving on the
