

EBAN'S 2 POINT PEACE PROGRAM

PARIS (WNS) -- In an interview broadcast over a French radio network, Israel's Foreign Minister Abba Eban said peace talks between Israel and Egypt could begin with discussions of two concrete issues -- Sharm el-Sheikh and the establishment of "a balance of forces" in the Middle East.

Eban declared that the balance of power could be advanced by the demilitarization of the Sinai. If the Egyptians show themselves "supple and conciliatory" an agreement on borders can also be reached, he said. However, he added, Israel must retain permanent control of Sharm el-Sheikh in view of what happened in 1967.

Eban admitted that there had been unofficial contacts with the Soviet

Union, but said "I would much prefer a change of Soviet policy without secret contacts than secret contacts and no change of Russian policy."

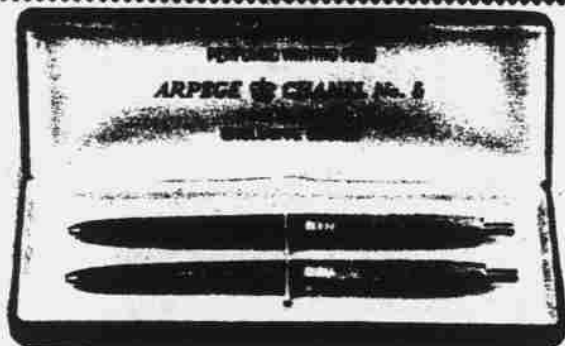
In other comments, Eban noted two obstacles to improved Franco-Israeli relations, refusal of Israel's request to agree with the Common France's Market to safeguard its exports to Europe; and French insistence that Israel evacuate "all the occupied territories." He also said that the Palestine problem had to be solved by the Arabs themselves.

SOVIET POLICE SCHEME TO ARREST JEWS

NEW YORK (WNS) --The National Conference on Soviet Jewry has reported that rumors are circulating in Moscow that "The People's Liberation Movement of Jews in the Soviet Union" was created last month by several Jews and Russians.

The NCSJ said Moscow Jews fear the rumors are to be used as an excuse for the KGB, Soviet secret police, to prepare for the arrest and trials of Jewish activists in the Soviet Union.

In Kiev, it was reported, when 60 young Jews tried to enter the synagogue, four of them were arrested and sentenced to 15 days. Police actions were also reported that Vladimir Slepak, 44, a physicist and electronics engineer who had been dismissed from his job after applying for visas for his family to emigrate to Israel, had been threatened with jail
