An Open Letter 70 Justice David Zenoff



CHIEF JUSTICE DAVE

Hon. David Zenoff Chief Justice Nevada Supreme Court

Dear Dave:

There are members of the Jewish Com-munity, ourself included, who are appalled at the compromising position you have been put in by Sun publisher Hank Greenspun.

If members of our own religion who know you, and trust you, and believe in you, are fearful of your excellent opportunity for reelection, we hesitate to contemplate what others are muttering.

We are referring to Greenspun's interpretation of a recent opinion you wrote in the litigation involving Robert Maheu and Howard Hughes. The matter before the Supreme Court concerned the taking of depositions of Howard Hughes.

District Judge Howard Babcock had stayed the depositions until a previous order had been complied with.

You, Justice Zenoff, overruled Babcock, which is perfectly proper in rendering an opinion, a function of the Supreme Court, just as it
