ace, Sunday, March 26.

While the affair is in conjunction with the fund-raising drive to complete the furnishings at New Child Haven, the dinner itself is more in the nature of a "Thank You" publicly for Sammy. That is why the tickets are priced at the very low, low \$10.00.

The new Child Haven at 3401 E. Bonanza, with facility to house up to 120 youths, was commenced under authorization of \$380,000 by the Clark County Commissioners. The Children's Service Guild of So. Nev. appealed to the Fleishmann Foundation and received a donation of an additional \$225,000, enough to complete the buildings, thereupon. In his Las Vegas stopover, during a swing through the Western states, Jewish War Veterans National Commander Jerome D. Cohen, said he will ask President Nixon for a definite statement on Soviet Jewry.

Cohen expects Pres. Nixon to speak out on the subject to the Russians during his May visit and ask what they intend to do about Jews who wish to emigrate. "One word from Pres. Nixon would be effective," said Cohen, who had just spent eight days in Russia. "The Soviet Jews view him (Nixon) as their Messiah," he emphasized. "The Soviets are sensitive to world opinion," said Cohen.

He told of Jews in a small Moscow synagogue he attended, not

being permitted to talk to him, but reached out to touch his coat as he walked up the aisle.

ISRAELI MUNICIPALITIES PROTEST

TEL AVIV (WNS)-- Mayors and city council chairmen of all Israeli municipalities have threatened to resign in a tax dispute with the government.

The municipalities need an additional \$18 million in tax revenue. The government fears a tax rise would jeopardize its efforts to keep wages as low as possible.

The city officials agreed to wait for two months before taking any action.

An Open Letter To
Justice David Zenoff



CHIEF JUSTICE DAVE

Dear Dave:

There are members of the Jewish Community, ourself included, who are appalled at the compromising position you have been put in by Sun publisher Hank Greenspun.

If members of our own religion who know you, and trust you, and believe in you, are fearful of your excellent opportunity for reelection, we hesitate to contemplate what others are muttering.

We are referring to Greenspun's interpretation of a recent opinion you wrote in the litigation involving Robert Maheu and Howard Hughes. The matter before the Supreme Court concerned the taking of depositions of Howard Hughes.

District Judge Howard Babcock had stayed the depositions until a previous order had been complied with.

You, Justice Zenoff, overruled Babcock, which is perfectly proper in rendering an opinion, a function of the Supreme Court, just as it
