

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

MEXICO CITY (WNS)--Rabbi Dr. Abraham M. Hersberg, president of the Union of Rabbis of Latin America said he had been assured by President Salvador Allende Gossens "that he will not allow any destruction of the Jewish community" in Chile.

ALBANY (WNS)--The New York State Assembly by a vote of 127-9 approved a bill which would ban the holding of elections for New York City's 26 anti-poverty agencies on the Sabbath or holy days of all religious groups. Senate passage is expected.

NEW YORK (WNS)--The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith announced it was bringing suit in State Supreme Court to prevent the so-called "Arab Anti-Defamation League" (AADL) from using the phrase "Anti-Defamation League" as part of its name.

CHICAGO (WNS)--For the second successive year, the Jewish Welfare Fund of Metropolitan Chicago is offering scholarships to local youths to enable them to participate in summer work-study programs in Israel.

ROME (WNS)--Admiral Gino Birindelli, former commander of NATO forces in southern Europe, announced he would be a candidate for Parliament on the neo-Fascist Italian Social Movement (MSI) ticket.

GARY, IND. (WNS)--A resolution approved by the National Black Political Convention held here which advocated the "dismantling" of Israel was criticized as "very unfortunate" by this city's Black Mayor Richard G. Hatcher.

LONDON (WNS)--Soviet Jewish sources reported all the windows in the synagogue in Khusht, in the Carpathian Ukraine, were smashed by Vandals. The synagogue's walls were recently daubed with anti-Semitic slogans.

LOS ANGELES (WNS)--The District Attorney's office has dropped charges of assault with intent to commit murder against Irving S. Rubin, 28-year-old leader of the Jewish Defense League here.

NEW YORK (WNS)--The Joint Distribution Committee will provide ORT, the Organization for Rehabilitation through Training with \$2,850,000 for its 1972 vocational training programs in Europe, North Africa, Iran, India and Israel.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--Francois Mitterand, leader of the French Socialist Party, arrived here at the head of a six man party delegation and denied reports that he had expressed support of the position of the Palestinian refugees.

DETROIT (WNS)--A lecture series honoring an alumnus of its class of 1932, who was responsible for saving more than 50,000 Hungarian Jews from death camps during World War II, was launched at the University of Michigan. Honored was Raoul Gustaf Wallenberg, son of a wealthy Swedish family who volunteered to aid Jewish refugees. He was appointed third secretary at the Swedish Legation in Budapest in 1944, where he was responsible for the protection and relief of Jews.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Mrs. Hermine Braunsteiner Ryan, married to an American citizen, who lost her citizenship in Sept. 1971 for having concealed her membership in the Nazi SS on her citizenship application, now faces a deportation hearing.

NEW YORK (WNS)--A survey by the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith has found that at least eight of the 14 United States Senators mentioned in the anti-Israel Lillenthal newspaper advertisement repudiate both the ad and what they call the implication that they endorsed it.

WASHINGTON (WNS)--Eighty-nine editors and publishers of the Yiddish and Anglo-Jewish press and wire-services met with top officials of the Nixon Administration at the White House for briefings on the President's achievements on topics of general and Jewish interest. They were briefed on the Administration's approach to the problems of Soviet Jewry and the Middle East.
