

# BILBRAY FOR CONGRESSMAN

University of Nevada Regent James H. Bilbray formally announced his candidacy for Nevada's lone seat in Congress, coupling it with a blistering attack on Rep. Walter Baring's "failure to protect Nevadans from intimidation and encroachment by the Internal Revenue Service and other federal agencies."

The 33-year-old Las Vegas attorney stated that "Mr. Baring has been shuffling around Congress for so long he does not know Nevadans are afraid of losing their

jobs and their constitutional rights as a result of federal harassment."

A former deputy district attorney, Bilbray noted that several federal grand juries and strike forces have been assembled outside Nevada investigating the state's gambling industry.

"The federal government, our government, acts like a hostile foreign power," Bilbray said, "with invading armies on our borders and a fifth column of hundreds of federal agents secretly in-

filtrating Nevada casinos and hotels."

Bilbray, a member of the Nevada State Commission on Higher Education, said he was making his announcement in Reno to emphasize the statewide nature of his campaign.

He said "the final clincher in my decision to run was the enthusiastic reaction I have received from people in Washoe and the smaller Nevada counties during my travels these past months."

Bilbray pledged an energetic campaign in the Democratic primary, saying that he would "vigorously walk the streets of Nevada so that I can proudly walk the halls of Congress, rather than having to stumble, like my opponent, through a forgotten history of unremembered promises."

He stated that Baring's "disloyalty to the Democratic party" would be a major issue in his primary campaign for Congress.

"Unlike Mr. Baring, I am not ashamed to be seen with Democratic party workers, nor am I afraid to support Democratic candidates," declared Bilbray, a member of both his party's state and county central committees and Chairman of the Democrats' Voter

Registration Drive.

Elected university regent in 1968, Bilbray led a successful fight to end secret regents' meetings.

Mr. Bilbray has been actively involved in community affairs as a Little League Baseball Coach, an active member in the Junior Chamber of Commerce, former student body president, UNLV, and a two sport letterman. Mr. Bilbray was also a sponsored executive of the United Fund and was UNLV's first Alumni president.

Because of his law enforcement and youth activities background, Bilbray has taken a firm stand against crime and drug addiction, saying if elected he would fight to end foreign aid "to any country unwilling or unable to stop the production and export of heroin to the U.S."

A native Nevadan, he received both his government and public administration and law degrees from American University in Washington, D.C., and served on Senator Howard Cannon's staff while in Washington.

Bilbray is married to the former Michaelene Mercer and has three children. His father, James A. Bilbray, is the popular Clark County Assessor.

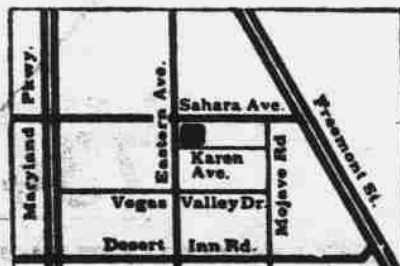
