



BLACKS AGAIN GONDEMN ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) --The steering committee the National Black Political' Convention, meeting in Washington March 24, unanimously-reaffirmed the condemnation of Israel approved by a voice vote in the closing minutes of the convention held in Gary, Ind. March 12.

The steering committee meeting was attended by Mayor Richard G. Hatcher of Gary, who had previous-ly condemned the convention resolution, and by Rep. Charles C. Diggs Jr. (D., Mich),one of 13 members of the Black Political Caucus which on March 21 had issued a unanimous statement in defense of Israel's existence.

A spokesman for the committee said the committee had approved a "revised" and "softened" version of the convention resolution which had called for the dismemberment of Israel.

The "revised" resolution condemned Israel for the "forceful occupation" of Arab territory but eliminated the call for Israel's dismemberment.
