NUNS WANT JERUSALEM UNDER ISRAEL

ATLANTA -- The National Coalition of American Nuns called for continuation of Jerusalem under Israeli control. In a statement issued by the Executive Council of the 2,000 member body, the Coalition opposed "any possible internationalization of the Holy City."

The statement continued, "Jews have always been in Jerusalem. It is their spiritual home and the daily prayer of the Jewish people voices their enduring historic relation to the city. Further, Israel has rebuilt Jerusalem pouring into it millions of dollars and more especially, untold human resources. Jerusalem is now available to all faiths and never before have the holy places been so protected and maintained."

The National Coalition of American Nuns is organized to study, speak and work for social justice. Its Executive Council met in Atlanta during the Leadership Meeting of Women Religious.

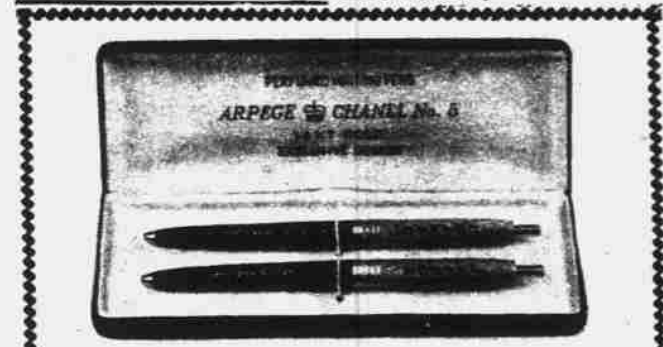
