FRONTIER FIDELITY EARNINGS

R. Julian Moore, Chairman of the Board and D.F. Osman, President of Frontier Fidelity Savings and Loan Association announced that earnings for the Quarter ending March 31, 1972 were \$99,226, compared with an earnings loss of (\$16,079) reported for the same period in 1971.

Earnings per share for the first Quarter of 1972 were \$0.12 compared to a loss of (\$0.02) reported for the same period in 1971. Earnings per share are based upon 826,700 shares outstanding for each year.

Mr. Osman stated that the earnings gain registered by Frontier Savings was due in part to a reduction in borrowings from the Federal Home Loan Bank and of Senior Capital Notes totalling \$5,606,500. These reductions were made

possible by the continued increase in savings deposits totalling \$4,088,000 during the first quarter of 1972.

Reduced borrowings means reduced operating expenses, which in turn provides greater stability to Frontier's earnings gain and future earnings potential.
