BLACK LEADER SAYS BLACKS WERE EXPLOITED BY MOSLEMS, NOT HEBREWS

EASE ISRAEL'S HOUSING SHORTAGE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Plans to eliminate the practices that now costs the economy "hundreds of millions of pounds annually" were submitted to Israeli officials at the end of a week-long symposium of housing construction experts that include experts from abroad.

The proposed remedies included cutting the red tape that takes an average of 18 months to get the building license approved, and the introduction of new materials and construction methods. The symposium, which was headed by Jack D. Weiler, the Jewish Agency's Housing committee chairman, stated that "delays due to manpower shortages, unavailability of equipment and material, bureaucratic decision, lack of planning and organization and inability to readily adapt to innovations and other constraints are costing Israel's economy hundreds of millions of

pounds annually. Weiler said a coordinator on behalf of the committee would be appointed to follow through on the recommendations. He would have success to all nine ministers and ministries who presently must approve all building plans. After the release of the critical report, Weiler told news men that building starts in Israel were twice that in the New York Metropolitan areas which has a population of 11 million. He also pointed out that in Tokyo, the capital of a highly industrialized nation, 36 percent of the population live in sub-standard housing. There were "limitations" to what could be accomplished, he said.

GOLDA MEIR TO VISIT RUMANIA

JERUSALEM (WNS) --Premier Golda Meir will visit Rumania early in May for a 4-5 day visit it was announced. This will be the first visit by an Israeli Premier to any Communist country.

It was believed the trip was linked to President Nixon's forthcoming visit to Moscow. Soviet leaders were believed eager to learn Israel's position, through Rumania, before his visit. Also expected to be explored was Rumania's willingness to act as a mediator between Israel and the Arab states. Rumania is the only Communist country which did not break relations with Israel because of the Six Day War.

The trip was viewed by observers both here and abroad as a triumph for Israeli diplomacy.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Black civil rights leader Bayard Rustin has denounced the resolution calling for the dismantling of Israel which was adopted by voice vote in the closing minutes of the National Black Political Convention in Gary, Ind., March 12. Writing in the N.Y. Amsterdam News, Rustin scored the myth that "Israel is the enemy of Black Africa." Historically, Black

nations were exploited not by Hebraic peoples, he wrote, but "by the Moslem Kingdoms that plundered the continent's wealth and enslaved and murdered its inhabitants well in advance of the European colonial expeditions.

Nor have racial and religious hostilities between Moslems and Black Africa disappeared with the passing years."

Greenspun's Sun Hides Behind 1st Amendment

If Sun publisher Hank Greenspun and his disciple, Paul Price, get away with what they are attempting in their recent caper with the Clark County Grand Jury, it will be triumph of deceit and cowardice over honesty and courage of conviction.

Price, on separate occasions stated there were \$50,000 and \$100,000 payoffs to county officials for gambling licenses. That's all he said. No information as to who received the money, who gave it, and the gambling licenses involved. This is an accusation made in America, where persons accused are entitled to face their accuser.

When Price was called an extortionist by an honest newspaperman (our son), Price promptly sued. Commission Chairman Jim Brennan requested a Grand Jury investigation of Price's charges. Ruthe Deskin, Greenspun's assistant, and Price were subpoenaed to appear.
