NEW YORK (WNS) -- Ten young Soviet Jewish activists, who were among the 36 individuals who asked to meet with President Nixon when he visits Moscow in May, have been called up for two-months active duty in the Soviet Armed forces.

Richard Maass, chairman of the National Conference on Soviet Jews, charged this was a device to "clear" Moscow of persons who might prove embarrassing to the Soviet regime during the President's visit.

In Washington, Rep. Bertram L. Podell (D., N.Y.), charged the reserve units the men were attached to were not called up and that their draft boards had to change their military papers to induct them. He urged the House to cable Soviet leaders to "tell them that the U.S. Congress will not accept a detente if it means Jews with the courage to stand for freedom will be dragged off to the army not to be heard of for two months, if ever."
