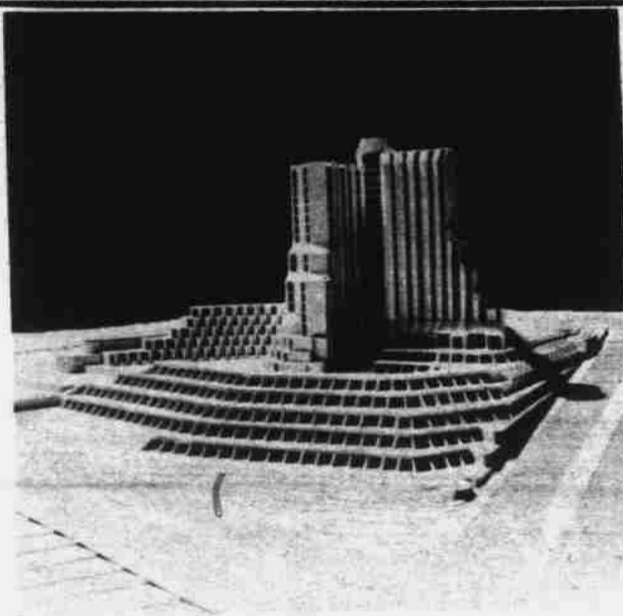

RUMANIA, CORDIAL TO MEIR, WILL NOT MEDIATE CONFLICT IN MIDEAST

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Golda Meir returned after her three day state visit to Rumania and expressed thanks for the warm reception she had received in Bucharest but denied that Rumania would serve as a mediator in the Middle East conflict now or in the future.

The joint communique released here and in Bucharest at the end of her visit, was couched in general terms and stressed bilateral relations between the two countries, and "the possibilities of their further development as well as on international issues of mutual interest."

It also reaffirmed the

belief of both nations that "relations among states should be based on the observance of the principles of national independence and sovereignty, non-interference in domestic affairs and equal rights and mutual advantage on the observance on the right of each people to decide freely its own fate without any outside interference."

A member of Mrs. Meir's entourage said the reception given Mrs. Meir in Rumania "has never been given to an Israeli Premier in a Western country." But though the three day visit was conducted in an atmosphere of warmth

All Mr. Hughes Hotels Now Operating in Black

Last week, for the first time, the full seven Howard Hughes Nevada casinos, hotel-casinos commenced operating in the black.

The last to get on the credit side of the ledger was the Castaways, the smallest of the casino-hotel operations. Three weeks ago, the Desert Inn, the first Hughes casino-hotel, began registering a profit.

Now the whole story may be told.

We all know that Howard Hughes is a most unusual man, with far more not known about his personal life and business activities than has been written by profit-seeking "biographers and a phoney "autobiographer."

But certain facts are evident from the circumstances surrounding the story of Hughes in Nevada. It is a story of multi-million dollar cash transactions at a time when the country was economically depressed. It is a story of misplaced confidence in a man, with the power of the check-book pen, who Hughes described as "robbing me blind." It is the story of the most corrupt newspaper publisher in America snatching in excess of \$10,000,000 in cash under most unusual and suspicious circumstances while "working" for the billionaire, but as soon as the cash flow stopped, commenced the most vicious campaign of hate propaganda and character assassination ever perpetrated in the annals of journalism. It is the story of a stubborn governor, elected by the corrupt publisher who created obstacles to harass and embarrass Hughes, and most important, served to undermine the confidence of 8,000 employees in the security of their jobs. And finally, it is a story of a state gambling commission, acting under the influence of the corrupt publisher and the stubborn governor, refusing to license the designated persons so that the largest business in the state can be properly operated to function smoothly.

Despite all this, Hughes was determined to stick it out, and he emerged successful. Only Hughes could have sustained. Other big business, in the gambling industry, involved in stock transactions, mergers, huge bank loans and promoted investors, would and did run at the first sign of financial set-back. Not Hughes, who kept pouring in more and more money, maintaining full staffs, meeting all obligations.

Through it all Hughes did not neglect his

CHAIN OF JEWISH SCHOOLS IN U.S.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Rabbi Shlomo Goren, Chief Rabbi of Tel Aviv and former chief chaplain of Israel's Armed Forces, urged leaders of the American Zionist Federation to see to it that "Jewish children are not deprived of a full Jewish education" and to "establish a solid chain of Jewish schools throughout the United States."

Calling the U.S. "the greatest reservoir of Jewry for the political and spiritual support necessary for the survival of Israel," He warned that unless America's Jewish youth receive a full Jewish education "this support may be lost to us in the next generation."

Also in New York, Yigal Allon, Israel's Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education and Culture, told 100 American Jewish educational leaders that Jewish education is "the major instrument which can help us to preserve the Jewish People." Speaking to a reception of the Board of Jewish

Education of New York and the American Association for Jewish Education, Allon said "I truly believe that education in general -- and Jewish education in particular -- is perhaps the only instrument of advancing humanity and preserving Jewishness."

PROPOSE CUTBACKS TO HALT INFLATION

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Moshe Zanbar, Governor of the Bank of Israel, has presented to the Cabinet proposals to end the rapidly rising inflation spiral.

He proposed an immediate end to all new public building and urged mortgages be made more expensive.

He also proposed a six month moratorium on all new development projects, and suggested the government sell some of its holdings in various companies and well as government credit for development projects; and called for higher interest on government bonds and savings plans.

COMPLETE DESTRUCTION OF ISRAEL

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- In a May Day speech in Alexandria,

Egyptian President Anwar Sadat declared that Egypt would not be satisfied with the liberation of the territories occupied by Israel but only with "the complete destruction of the Israeli arrogance."

Declaring that Egypt was prepared to a sacrifice a million men in the battle against Israel Sadat added "The Russians help us with armaments but we shall fight by ourselves."

At a religious ceremony in Cairo on April 25, Sadat said: "We shall not only liberate the Arab lands and Jerusalem and break Israel's pride of victory, but we will return them to the state in which the Korea described them: to be persecuted, suppressed and miserable."
