and friendly feeling, the nations did not reconcile their differences in their approach to the Middle East problem.

Rumania's Pres. Nicolae Ceausescu reportedly tried to move Israel from her position that there must be no preconditions to peace talks, meaning that Israel will not withdraw from the occupied territories before the talks begin.

Pres. Ceausescu was believed to have tried to convince Mrs. Meir that Egyptian Pres. Anwar Sadat wanted peace, while she was reported to have assured Ceausescu that Sadat does not seek peace, but only new positions from which he would be better able to attack Israel.

RUSSIA ERRED ALLOWING JEWS TO LEAVE FOR ISRAEL

NEW YORK -- A noted authority on Soviet Russia told the American Jewish Committee, which is closing its 66th Annual Meeting, that the Soviet authorities had made a basic policy miscalculation when they decided to allow Soviet Jews to leave for Israel.

Dr. Maurice Friedberg, Professor of Slavic Languages and Literature at Indiana University, told a session of the Annual Meeting that the Soviet leaders had hoped to defuse an explosive issue by getting rid of their "Zionist troublemakers," with the expectation that the rest of Soviet Jewry left behind would become passive.

Instead, Dr. Friedberg continued, "the newly arrived Soviet Jews in Israel have served to strengthen the

links between the Jews of the U.S.S.R. and the rest of the world. Thus the problem, far from being defused, was perhaps intensified. Evidence of this may be found not only in continued mass applications for exit permits, but also in the numerous recent petitions of Soviet Jews to allow in the Soviet Union the teaching of Hebrew -- a subject not taught in any Soviet schools."

ISRAEL HAS ALL ARMS IT NEEDS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Yizhak Rabin, Israel Ambassador to the U.S. told the 300 people attending the two-day conference of the American-Israel Public Affairs Committee that U.S. - Israeli relations have now reached "a peak of understanding."

Dr. Friedberg reported that there was intensified harassment of Jews waiting to emigrate from the Soviet Union but that the actual flow of emigrants was still considerable. He suggested that the approximately 20,000 Soviet Jews who have arrived in Israel since the beginning of last year represent perhaps 10 per cent of those who wished to leave the Soviet Union.

ONLY YIDDISH TEACHERS U.S. COLLEGE

DEAN HERZLIAH- JEWISH TEACHERS COLL.

On 69 Bank Street, in the West Village of New York, there stands a modest, five story building which contains a unique institution consisting of two schools: the only Yiddish Teachers College in America and the only non-denominational Hebrew Teachers Institute in the area.

The institution trains teachers for all types of Jewish schools, and professors for schools of higher Jewish learning and for Judaic studies in American colleges and universities. Many hundreds of its graduates serve Jewish schools in this country and abroad. It is the Herzliah-Jewish Teachers College, an amalgamation of the Herzliah Hebrew Teachers Institute and the Jewish Teachers Seminary and People's University, which took place in 1967.

The Jewish Teachers Seminary is a school of higher Jewish learning conducted in Yiddish, organized and in great measure sustained by the Jewish Labor elements in this country. Leading Labor organizations, the Labor Zionist Alliance, the Workmen's Circle, the Pioneer Women, and the Sholem Aleichem Folk Institute, participate in the financing and direction of the school. Its membership includes the Jewish Labor Committee, the Congress for Jewish Culture and a number of labor unions.

"An institution to train, in the light of scientific knowledge and historical Jewish ideals, men and women for the Jewish teaching profession, for research and community service; to study scientifically Jewish History, religion and ethics, literature, and social and labor relations; to make available to the general public constructive knowledge of the spiritual and social ideals of the Jewish people, their history and their Jewish and social scholarship..."

These are the aims of the Seminary stated in its articles of incorporation, adopted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of New York and signed by Governor Herbert H. Lehman in 1935, giving it the status of a chartered college. The school was organized in 1918 as a university for all the people, an institution which would appeal to all who are interested in the enhancement of constructive Jewish life. Among its incorporators was His Excellency, Zalman Shazar, President of the State of Israel.
