BILBRAY LASHES OUT AT BARING

University Regent James Bilbray has branded Rep. Walter S. Baring's handling of efforts to secure a veterans' out-patient clinic for Southern Nevada "a cruel deception exercised solely for political gain."

During a meeting with local veterans of the Vietnam War, Bilbray lashed out at Baring's statement to the effect that the congressman would now apply pressure to secure a permanent out-patient clinic here.

"This," Bilbray said, "after 12 years of lip service to our veterans wherein Baring dangled hopes for location of a 400-bed veterans hospital which he knew all along was beyond reach for Southern Nevada."

Bilbray recalled a December 30, 1960 article in the Las Vegas Review-Journal in which Lou Licker, com-

mander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1753, had urged Baring to seek and out-patient clinic.

"Baring instead rejected this feasible, necessary facility and made a grandstand play for a hospital in nothing more than outrageous bid for veterans' votes," Bilbray said.

"For 12 years Baring has gambled that no one would uncover the big lie, for he knew full well that the Veterans Affairs Committee has absolutely no power to

provide Southern Nevada -- or any other area -- with a veterans' hospital," Bilbray asserted.

"That lie was unmasked," Bilbray said, "in letters from Rep. Olin

Teague, chairman of the committee, and Rufus Wilson, associate deputy administrator of the Veterans Administration, on June 30, 1971."
