NIXON MAY SEE JEWISH ACTIVISTS IN MOSCOW, MIDEAST PROBLEM???

FIRST WOMAN RABBI

NEW YORK -- Miss Sally Priesand, who on June 3rd will become the first woman rabbi in the history of American Judaism, is the subject of a major article in the current (June) issue of LADIES' HOME JOURNAL.

Miss Priesand gave her reasons for becoming a rabbi in the article: "I believe in God. I believe in the worth of the individual. I believe in Judaism as a way of life," she stated. "I believe that Judaism is worth preserving; I just happen to believe that the rabbinate is the best way that I can fulfill these beliefs."

In describing Miss

Priesand, the JOURNAL states, "CHAIM is the Hebrew word for life. It's the most appropriate word for Sally. She understands life, respects it, loves it, and lives it fully. This should make her a great rabbi as well as a first!"

When asked about the Women's Liberation Movement, Miss Priesand said she has "never felt the need to be liberated." She doesn't see her own career as a struggle against male domination. She asserted in the JOURNAL article she "just wanted to be a rabbi and didn't think about whether or not women could be."

JEW'S PRAY FOR WALLACE

NEW YORK -- The American Jewish Congress deplored the "senseless and brutal" attack on Governor George Wallace.

Rabbi Arthur Hertzberg of Englewood, N.J. new president of the Congress, declared:

"Even those who disagree most profoundly

with Governor Wallace on almost every issue before the American public must join in condemning this outrageous act of violence against him personally and inevitably against the democratic process.

"We join other Americans in praying for his full and speedy recovery."

WESTERN GUARD ANTI-SEMITES

TORONTO (WNS) -- Some 130 people, including "fraternal delegates" from the Klux Klan and former members of the American Nazi Party, attended the 15th anniversary meeting of the Western Guard (formerly the Edmund Burke Society).

It was the first time the Western Guard had openly fraternized with avowed anti-Semites.

WASHINGTON (WNS)

-- As Pres. Nixon prepared for his trip to Moscow, informed sources here indicated that talks on the Middle East would center on Soviet-U.S. interests in the area rather than on solving the Arab-Israeli impasse. While the USSR is anxious to discuss the Middle East, the U.S. is insistent that the Arabs and Israelis make their own settlement without imposition of agreements by the major powers. There was speculation that during his Moscow visit the President would meet with some of the Jewish activists who had expressed a desire to meet with him. At the

same time unconfirmed rumors circulated that the American Embassy in Moscow had been asked to use its influence with Soviet Jews to see that no demonstration be held regarding emigration to Israel and the right to live Jewish lives in the USSR during the President's visit.

In Jerusalem, Defense Minister Moshe Dayan, at a meeting of the Knesset faction of the Labor Alignment, predicted that after the summit meeting the U.S. and USSR would seek new measures to break the Middle East deadlock. He said the USSR was concerned be-

You got to give Sun publisher Hank Greenspun credit for consistency. He's always in there punching ---- for Greenspun.

Self-proclaiming he is the "Savior of Nevada," this "Great Redeemer" keeps preaching what is necessary to cure our state of its ills. He never misses the opportunity to appear in some far-away spot to "extoll the virtues" of Las Vegas, to "protect the fair name" of our city ----he says. It always sounds like that when his corrupt newspaper reports the event to our local readers.

But if anyone should take the trouble of even a casual perusal of what actually transpired, it never fails, that what Greenspun says he said, "aint" necessarily so. He sets himself up as a "one man promotion" to protect us. It should read, "its a set-up" to promote one man" --himself, protecting Greenspun.

We first caught on to this man's phoney twist when he appeared on the David Suskind TV show. The occasion was an invitation for someone in authority to come to the defense of Nevada against the charges made in "Greenfelt Jungle," a book written by a reporter working on Greenspun's Sun. It was written on the sly, in the home of a Greenspun crony, Morry Stevens. The book was an expose of the gangster element associated with Nevada's legalized gambling.

The TV show was a round-robin forum to discuss the pros and cons of the book. Gov. Grant Sawyer declined the invitation to appear. Others in high office also refused, not wishing to dignify the charges in the book. Greenspun volunteered to appear.

Isn't that nice? We had someone brave enough to appear on a nationwide show and protect our good name. Greenspun was the authority who was going to explain the mechanics of gambling. His explanation became involved with "takes" from the cashier's cage and the intricacies of the counting room. When the others, a federal lawman, a big city prosecutor, the author and co-writer, and others got through throwing questions at Greenspun, he threw up his hands and said words to the effect, "I don't know about anyone else. I'm here to protect myself."

Much to our amazement, for years we have been hearing Greenspun brag about the publicity
