ARAB TERRORISTS PLANNING MORE MURDERS SAYS LONE JAP SURVIVOR

TERRORISTS BOAST OF SLAUGHTER

LONDON (WNS) -- A spokesman for the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine told the Manchester Guardian in Beirut, Lebanon, his group was responsible for the massacre at Lydda Airport.

He said "Our purpose was to kill as many people as possible at the airport -- Israelis, of course, but anyone else who was there." He also stated, "We have many more surprises in store for Israel."

News of the massacre was the occasion for celebrations in Arab capitals, but Jordan's King Hussein denounced the shootings as a "crime committed by a mentally sick group." At the United Nations, Lebanon's Ambassador Edouard Ghorri disclaimed his government's responsibility for the killings.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Puerto Rican survivors of the Lydda Airport massacre have decided to tour Israel as they had planned.

FRENCH SECURITY SOFTENED, SAY PILOTS, EARLIER THIS YEAR

PARIS (WNS) -- The French government condemned the Lydda Airport massacre and denied responsibility for the tragedy.

At the same time Israel's Ambassador to France, Asher Ben Natan, and Israel's Premier Golda Meir, implied that France had rejected warnings that "irresponsible elements might use French planes" to mount an attack on Israel.

Speaking at Grenoble at the opening of Israel Week, Ben Natan said "It is up to the airlines to insure that its passengers do not carry weapons." But an Air France spokesman said the Japanese gunmen boarded the plane at Rome and the Italian authorities "would have to speak for their own security measures."

Meanwhile, as Air France "confirmed" that "appropriate security measures have never ceased to be applied to flights serving the Middle East," they were contradicted by the French Union of Airline Pilots. In a statement, the union stated it "regretted to announce" that Air France "softened" some security measures and "cancelled" others on Middle East flights earlier this year.

MANY JAPS ARAB TRAINED

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israeli officials believe Arab terrorists are preparing new murderous attacks against civilians in Israel and Europe.

The belief is based both on the knowledge that more Japanese leftists are training at terrorist camps in Lebanon and the remarks of the surviving Japanese terrorist who killed 25 people and wounded more than 70 others at Lydda Airport May 30. Namba Dai Aska, a name police believe to be an alias, reportedly told his interrogators that he would remain silent for one week and only then "tell the truth."

The massacre oc-

curred when three Japanese gunmen on an Air France flight entered the air terminal, took Russian made Kalachnikov submachine guns from their valises and began shooting into the crowd and tossing grenades. One of the gunmen was killed by a grenade. Another was shot by his companion. All three were members of a Japanese terror group known as "Red Star" which is responsible for 14 assassinations in Japan and the hijacking of a Japanese passenger airliner to Korea two years ago.

Saka told police the three men had trained at an Arab terrorist (Continued on Page 3)

WHOLE WORLD STUNNED BY SENSELESS MURDERS OF CIVILIANS

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Condemnation of, and shock at, the senseless killings at Lydda Airport were voiced by Jewish, Christian leaders.

A Kaddish for the victims was recited at the 43rd annual convention of the National Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs in Miami Beach. Dr. David Stowe, executive vice-president of the United Church Board for World Ministries of

the United Church of Christ said "The world cannot endure such senseless and unfeeling disregard of the sanctity of human life nor such haphazard and hopeless attempts to settle political differences through terror."

Rabbi Israel Miller, president of the American Zionist Federation, asserted that "Israel's spirit will not be broken nor will American (Continued on Page 3)

U.S. CONGRESSMEN URGE BOYCOTT

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Congresswoman Bella Adzug (D., N.Y.) introduced a resolution in the House of Representatives urging Congress to call on all international airlines to boycott Beirut until such time as the Lebanese government takes "strong effective measures to terminate the existence of this group (the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine) or

any other similar group on its territory."

Rep. Hugh L. Carey (D., N.Y.) said "the tragic and brutal killing of innocent travelers is a crime against humanity."

Rep. Herman Badillo (D., N.Y.) said he was "deeply shocked" at the airport killings.

Sen. George McGovern (D., S.D.) denounced the "mindless terrorism" of the attack.

Mass Murder at Lod

THE LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE was so shocked by the massacre of innocent men, women and children in the Tel Aviv Air terminal, followed by rejoicing in Arab capitals, we postpone our regularly scheduled column to bring you the words of Mrs. Golda Meir, delivered to the Israeli Knesset on May 31:

Mr. Speaker, Members of the Knesset,

The Government feels duty-bound to make a statement in the Knesset and, by means of the Knesset, to the nation and the world throughout. I have nothing to add to the details which, as far as they have been verified, were made public. What happened last night at Lod Airport was a foul murderous deed, premeditated, with total disregard for human life and with one sole aim: to murder and to kill indiscriminately.

What happened yesterday caused the death of 23 and the wounding of 78 persons. Among those killed, identified so far, there are five-six Jews and twelve non-Jews, mainly Puertorican, pilgrims who came to visit the Holy Land in good faith -- and they had reason to believe that they would enter in peace and depart in peace. As far as Israel and the Jewish people are concerned, this is the way it could and ought to have been - but for the crime plotted abroad.

There are some elements in this crime which point to "a war of liberation" as it were, of the terrorist organizations, their war on imperialism and their linking up - according to them with the progressive revolutionaries throughout the world. And the proof of it: yesterday Japanese turned up.

The Arabs in the terrorist organizations found a way, not only to kill and wreak bloodshed. But also to do so by emissaries. And all this in the name of war against imperialism. What did the Japanese who was apprehended say: "World revolution." We betide such "world revolution" and local revolution, built on bloodshed and based on murder for its own sake.

As soon as the news of what happened broke, joy broke out in Cairo and in Beirut as well over the "great victory." Dozens of people were killed and scores of others wounded - and there is no end to the rejoicing. Those who were unable to stand up against us on the battlefield are great heroes at hiding explosives in planes, at assaults on planes and passengers, and in their readiness to blow up a plane with a hundred people aboard - as they did two years ago in the "Swissair" disaster.
