The letter to Waldheim was in response the Libyan Ambassador's circulation of a statement by the Palestine Liberation Organization that "no Arab state can be responsible" for the Tel Aviv shootings. Tekoah said the PLO was "the roof organ of Arab terror groups openly engaged in the campaign of murder directed against innocent and de-RISM AT MEMORIAL fenseless civilians" and noted that "only in the zations, said the Lydda Arab World" was there jubilation over the killings and "attempts to whitewash the crime." participated in the operation of the terror groups."

In an earlier letter to Mojsov, Tekoah charged that the Lebanese government is denying that "Lebanon's capital. Beirut, has become the seat of the terror organization's headquarters" was "wilfully distorting facts and ignoring the criminal activities in and out of Lebanon that have already resulted in the loss of numerous human lives." 
