

JEWIS AND REVOLUTIONARY FORCES

"The Relationship Between Jews and Revolutionary Forces" will be the theme for leading American Jewish and Israeli intellectuals participating in the 10th annual American Jewish Congress, August 1 to 4 at the Van Leer Institute in Jerusalem.

In formal papers and free-wheeling debate, the Dialogue participants will examine the role that various elements of the Jewish community have played in revolutionary movements, as well as the

impact that revolutionary political changes have had -- and are likely to have -- on Jewish life throughout the world.

Rabbi Arthur Hertzberg of Englewood, N.J., president of the American Jewish Congress and adjunct professor of history at Columbia University, will open the Dialogue proceedings Tuesday morning, Aug. 1, at the Van Leer Institute.

In announcing the Dialogue, Rabbi Hertzberg -- who is author of "The French Enlightenment and the

Jews" and "The Zionist Idea" and rabbi of Temple Emanu-El of Englewood -- said participant would examine, among other specific areas:

...The Russian Revolution and its impact on Jewish life in the U.S.S.R. and Israel;

...Problems arising from the revolutionary character of the Third World, including their effect on Israel's relationships with the emerging African nations;

...The active participation of many young Jews in sectors of the "New Left."

ENGLISH TEXTBOOKS FOR ISRAEL

The Books For Peace Council of Long Island announced that start of a National Campaign to provide English textbooks for Arab and Jewish students attending Israeli High Schools.

Rubin R. Dobin, of Lawrence, Long Island, N.Y., Council Chairman stated that the campaign is being conducted with the cooperation of the Haifa Branch of the Association of Americans and Canadians in Israel.

Thousands of students are now in High School classes taking up their studies in English. Texts of recent vintage in subjects such as literature, mathematics, sciences, history, politics, etc. are desired.

It is hoped that many families all over the land will check through their home libraries and choose the type of books that can be used by the Israeli students.

Dobin explained that these books can be sent to Israel via a cheap book rate that has been established by the United States Postal Service. He said that 11 pounds of books can be sent to Israel for \$1.44. About ten books can be sent in this manner, but books vary in

weight and care should be taken to make sure that each book package does not weigh more than 11 pounds. The package should be addressed to the following address: Association of Americans and Canadians in Israel (AACI) 124 Sderot Hanassi, Haifa, Israel. All books will be screened before being distributed to high

schools all over Israel.

A special effort is being made to secure the cooperation of school boards which may have suitable textbooks unused in warehouses. If they will communicate with Dobin at the Long Island Book Council, POB 11, Lawrence, New York 11559, he will make arrangements to have them picked up and shipped to Israel.

NEW YORK -- "1000 American students will be spending this summer in Israel at Tel Aviv University. 300 have enrolled in the one year study program. 25% of these remain to complete their undergraduate studies" according to Mr. Amnon Golan, Director of Academic Affairs, Overseas Student Programs of Tel Aviv University.

NEW YORK -- The appointment of two young professional workers - Steven J. Rod and David Waxman - as Associated in the Department of Program Development and Research of the National Jewish Welfare Board has been announced by Herbert Millman Executive Vice-President of JWB.
