## WALL STREET JOURNAL CONFIRMS HOW HANK GREENSPUN 'TOOK' H. HUGHES

### RELEASE JEWISH PRISONERS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Foreign Minister Abba Eban demanded the release of all Soviet Jews imprisoned for wanting to go to Israel. The Knesset then unanimously approved a resolution calling for the prisoners' release and for freedom for Soviet Jews wishing to

emigrate to Israel.

Eban charged the Soviet Union with conducting an active "terror campaign" to intimidate Jews from applying for visas to Israel. "But," he said, "just as these measures have failed in the past, so they will fail in the future as well."

### CONTROVERSY OVER KNESSET VOTE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Rabbi Zerah Zambrowsky, chairman of the World Mizrahi-Hapoel Hamizrachi movement and Rabbi Louis Bernstein, president of the Rabbinical Council of America, have come to the defense of the National Religious Party for abstaining on the halachic conversion bill vote.

In a statement issued here, Rabbi Zambrowsky lashed out at the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the U.S. and Canada for an advertisement they had published in the Jewish Daily Forward in New York on July 12 regar-

ding the NRP's abstention. He denied that Ashkenazic Chief Rabbi Isser Yehuda Unterman had issued a ruling that the NRP must vote against the conversion bill, and stated that Sephardic Chief Rabbi, Yitzhak Nissim and Rabbi Zvi Yehuda Kook son of the late Chief Rabbi Kook, had urged the NRP "against voting for the bill."

In New York, Rabbi Bernstein said "it took great courage" for the NRP to abstain on the vote since they "surely knew the torrent of volcanic abuse that would follow."

### RUSSIAN'S COERCE WITNESSES

LONDON (WNS) -- Soviet Jewish sources report the Soviet secret police are trying to involve three Moscow Jews, Vladimir Slepak, Valentina Prestin and Viktor Polski, in the trial of Vladimir Markman, which is to begin shortly in Sverdlovsk.

The three were promised quick action on their applications for exit visas if they testified against Markman. All three are reported to have refused.

It is feared the three may now be forced to stand trial as Markman's co-defendants. Markman is charged anti-Soviet slander.

### GOLDA MEIR OFFERS SADAT A 'SUPREME PEACE EFFORT'

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Golda Meir called upon Egyptian President Anwar Sadat to "make a joint supreme effort" to reach a peace settlement. Repeating her plea for negotiations without preconditions, Mrs. Meir expressed a willingness to accede to Sadat's request for a "special arrangement" to reopen the Suez Canal since, she said, such an agreement could make "a real contribution toward an overall agreed peace settlement."

Mrs. Meir, addressing the Knesset, said it was still too early for an evaluation of the effect of Sadat's ouster of Soviet military advisors from Egypt as it was not known how many troops and which equip-

ment would be withdrawn, and which equipment would be "integrated" into the Egyptian armed forces.

Commenting on Sadat's statement that he had ordered Soviet advisors out of Egypt because of the USSR's "Excessive caution," Mrs. Meir stated that if it is true that the Russians restrained the Egyptians from their more hostile impulses "then this contributed to saving Egypt from a further defeat and prevented a dangerous deterioration in the region." She warned that Israel would have to remain on the alert because "Who can guarantee that they (the Egyptians) will not try to find a solution or a way out of confusion, (Continued on Page 3)

The Hughes-Las Vegas love story that ended in divorce received columns and columns of space in the Wall Street Journal. It's mighty interesting reading.

What the Wall St. Journal had to say, for the most part, was "Howard Hughes Was Taken for a Ride By the Boys in Vegas." One of the leads to the WSJ story states: "An investigation by this newspaper discloses a massive loss of cash from the \$300 million Hughes Nevada empire through FRAUD, THEFT ----." And three paragraphs later:

AT LEAST \$4 MILLION WAS SECRETLY LENT OUT TO LAS VEGAS PUBLISHER HERMAN (HANK) GREENSPUN BY FORMER HUGHES EMPLOYEES AT INCREDIBLY FAVORABLE TERMS - FOR MR. GREENSPUN, NOT MR. HUGHES.

Here are excerpts from the Wall Street Journal story, printed in CAPS, that refer to Greenspun and related items.

THE IRS IS STILL PROBING THE FRONTIER ACQUISITION, AS WELL AS ALL THE OTHER HOTEL-CASINO PURCHASES TO SEE IF THERE WERE ANY INCOME TAX VIOLATIONS.

FEDERAL AGENTS HAVE ALSO DISCOVERED THAT FINDER'S FEES AMOUNTING TO
