frustration and internal strife by resuming fighting."

Mrs. Meir suggested that if Sadat found intolerable the "no-war-no-peace" situation he could end it by making peace directly with Israel because "no foreign country or factor can solve for us, or instead of us, the problems which stand between us . . . Negotiation for peace is not a badge of surrender or humiliation. . . It is responsibility," she said.

Israeli experts estimate that as many as 8,000 of the 17,000 Soviet experts and military personnel stationed in Egypt may be withdrawn, including advisors and technicians at the Aswan High Dam which was designed and built by Soviet engineers.

(In Washington, Rep. Peter Peyser (R., N.Y.) told the House that the reduction of Soviet personnel in Egypt was "encouraging" but "other recent statements" by Sadat "have demonstrated this is an appropriate time for the U.S. to reaffirm its commitment to support the State of Israel.")

(The State Department refused to comment on Sadat's charges that America had promised to pressure Israel to withdraw from the occupied territories and then broke the promise, instead increasing its aid to Israel.)

**HADASSAH SENDS FLOOD VICTIM CHILDREN TO SUMMER CAMP**

NEW YORK -- Five children, whose plans to attend summer camp washed away with the recent flood disasters in Harrisburg and Elmira won't be disappointed after all.

The families of these youngsters suffered such severe losses from the floods that they could no longer afford to send the children to camp.

When the National Board of Hadassah heard that these children had cancelled their plans to attend Camp Tel Yehuda, the national Young Judaea camp in Barryville, N.Y. sponsored by the Hadassah Zionist Youth Commission, an immediate allocation for camp scholarships was voted.

In addition, four Hadassah regions -- Northern New Jersey, Brooklyn, Suffolk and Lower New York State and members of the Board made additional

contributions.

The first camping period has already begun. One of the scholarship children arrived at camp with only the clothes on his back. Another child, whose clothes had been sent on ahead, now has all his worldly possessions in the lucky trunk.

Mrs. Jerome Paikin, Chairman of Hadassah's camp program, says that Hadassah is providing any clothing and camping equipment needed.

"Furthermore," she concluded, "we hope that during this period that the campers are with us, their parents will start to reconstruct their lives."

**ISRAELI TEENAGERS IN AMERICA**

NEW YORK -- Seventeen Israeli teenagers have been getting a taste the past week of what Jewish family life is like in the largest Jewish community of all.

Their nine-day stay in New York, each as house guest of a Jewish family in the metropolitan area, is part of a summer study tour conducted by the B'nai B'rith Youth Organization and designed to give the young visitors some first-hand experiences of Jewish life outside their native Israel.

The 17 are members of Noar Lenor (Youth to Youth), a 5,000-member movement that is the Israeli counterpart of the B'nai B'rith Youth Organization.

A similar contingent of Israeli youngsters visited the U.S. and Canada a year ago as a pilot project.

Summer tours of Israel by groups of American and Canadian teenagers have been a regular BBYO activity for a decade.

This year's Israeli group began its five week program with a four day visit to Montreal, followed by four days in New Haven, Conn., for a first-hand look at Jewish communal activities in a moderate-size city.

Mrs. Shapiro said she was "prepared to move and establish my home and family" in the Soviet Union "if there is no other alternative."

She said she would continue her efforts to obtain a visa to the Soviet Union.
