

D.A. WOOFER TO BID FOR 1974 NATL. D.A. ASSO. FOR LAS VEGAS

A formal bid to bring the 1974 National District Attorney's Association convention to Las Vegas will be made by District Attorney Roy Woofter during the organizations' summer conference scheduled in Puerto Rico beginning August 13.

Woofter hosted the 500-member Association's 1972 conference in Las Vegas last March.

It was the success of that conference and the scores of letters expressing interest in returning to Las Vegas

that prompted Woofter to contact members of the Association's site committee and propose Las Vegas be selected for the 1974 meeting.

"This is one of the most prestigious conventions in the Country," said Woofter. "It regularly draws more than 500 district attorneys and their wives from all parts of the nation."

Woofter said he felt it was his duty to the community as a whole to make every attempt to bring the convention to Las Vegas.

CARMAN NAMED DIRECTOR-COUNSELOR FOR OPERATION BRIDGE

Frank P. Carman, guidance counselor at Brinley Junior High school since 1970, has been named by the Executive Committee of Operation Bridge as the Director-Counselor of the youth outreach organization affiliated with the Southern Nevada Drug Abuse Council.

In addition to the Bachelor of Science degree in secondary education from the Pennsylvania institution, Carman holds the Master of Arts degree in guidance counseling and psychology from Northern A-

rizona State University. He was an English, speech and social studies teacher before entering the counseling field. He has also been trained for work with disadvantaged and low socio-economic groups.

Additional drug abuse experience which Carman will bring to the largely volunteer counseling agency at 116 Hoover, involves a close relationship with other professional educators, law enforcement and counseling individuals in Southern Nevada, according to the announcement.

Carman's responsibilities at Operation Bridge will include not only the outreach counseling program but also di-

rection of the 24-hour primarily with volunteer crisis telephone. He will hire an additional Executive Counselor but will work as in the past, the Committee said.

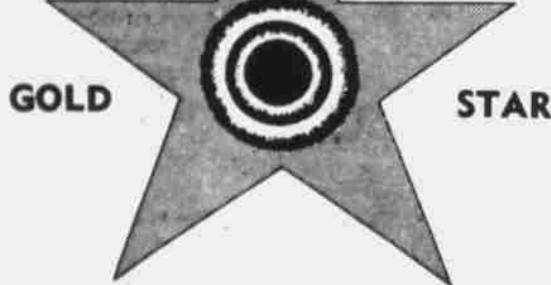
