# POLITICAL HOPEFULS

## BRENNAN FOR COUNTY COMMISSION

James Brennan, the young, dynamic chairman of the Board of Clark County Commissioners is seeking re-election on a record of achievement and accomplishment.

During Brennan's service, the people have enjoyed better government services, public facilities, recreation, roads, juvenile services and police protection.

"We have been able to do all of these things," Brennan said, "without any increase in taxes for the people."

Among the many accomplishment so the commission during the last four years, Bren-

nan said he is particularly proud of the multi-million dollar expansion of McCarran Airport, establishment of Spring Mountain Youth Camp at Angle's Peak, improvement and increased allocations for Child Haven youth facility, increased road construction and better police protection.

Brennan also said there has been "greater cooperation between 5 city and county governments than ever before," and said such cooperation "is in the best interest of ever local taxpayer."

Brennan was the first public official to call for a grand jury investigation of rumors and charges of payoffs in gaming matters. He also demanded a full public airing of charges involving alleged conflict of interest on a concession at McCarran Airport.

Brennan has served as a deputy district attorney, member of the Board of Hospital Trustees and as Justice of the Peace before his election to the county commission.

## POLITICAL BRIEFS

Congressman Walter S. Baring, voted to override the President's veto of the 1973 Health Education and Welfare appropriation bill this week which contained money, as Baring put it, "That certainly would go a long way toward helping the education system of this nation, the poor, elderly, blind and disabled, and the fight against cancer."

Congressman Walter S. Baring, supported three bills in the House of Representatives which would assist in programs curbing drug abuse, aiding cancer research, and improving traffic-motor vehicle safety. The bills were passed during the House sessions last Monday and Tuesday.

Senator George McGovern today accused the Soviet Union of holding educated Jews as "Hostages of the state" by increasing the fees they must pay to emigrate.

Passage in the House of Representatives of an anti-busing amendment had the full support of Congressman Walter S. Baring, who voted for the amendment in the Equal Education Opportunity Act which prohibits any busing except as a last resort.

Senator Howard Cannon, in a last-ditch effort to force a showdown with the Nixon Administration over impoundment of highway construction funds, has co-sponsored legislation forbidding the President from holding back funds appropriated by Congress to build roads.

Widows and children of deceased military pensioners would be eligible for government-subsidized benefits under a bill nearing final Senate action, Senator Howard Cannon has announced.
