NEW YORK -- Mayor John V. Lindsay has endorsed a proposal, made by the New York City chapter of the American Jewish Committee, to create a "consortium" of all parties concerned with the controversial Forest Hills housing project in order to ensure a mutually constructive relationship between the tenants of the project and the residents of the surrounding community.

NEW YORK -- The attitude of the Israeli Man in the street toward Germany has mellowed in the 27 years since the end of World War II, and only 18 per cent of the Israeli populace is now opposed to the existing diplomatic ties with that country, as indicated in a recent poll of the Jewish population of Israel by PORI-Public Opinion Research of Israel Ltd. and reported by the American Jewish Committee.

NEW YORK -- Rabbi Arthur Hertzberg of Englewood, N.J., president of the American Jewish Congress, called on American Jews to renew their "historically phalanced position between particular Jewish needs and the urgent problems of American society."
