Justice of the Peace Bob Legakes filed his candidacy Monday to retain his post.

Judge Legakes, 31, was appointed by the Clark County Commission after serving several years as public defender for the county.

A graduate of Los Angeles State College and of University of California Hastings Law School, Legakes is a member of the California, Nevada and Clark County Bar Associations and was admitted to practice before the Federal District Court.

After serving for more than a year as a law clerk in the office of Boyd, Leavitt & Freedman, Legakes joined the Clark County Public Defender's staff as a deputy in 1967. He served as public defender from July of 1970 to the date of assuming the bench earlier this month.

Judge Legakes and his wife, Glenda, are the parents of three children and reside at 2512 Natalie in Las Vegas.

JOHN VERGIELS FOR ASSEMBLY

John Vergiels candidate for Assembly, Dist. 10, pledges legislation to:

1. Guarantee written agreements in all leases and rentals. Contracts written in plain language that the layman can understand, and listing the obligations of both tenant and landlord.

JIM PHILLIPS FOR SUPREME COURT

Attorney James H. Phillips, 44, of 323 Las Vegas Blvd. South has filed as a candidate for the Nevada Supreme Court.

Phillips has been a resident of Las Vegas since 1958 when he joined the Clark County District Attorney's office. Since 1960 he has conducted a private law practice.

He is seeking a seat on the highest state court because he believes he is "young enough to have the energy required for the office yet old enough to have the experience, maturity and sound judgment to render the decisions that must be made."

Phillips says he favors holding some Supreme Court sessions outside the Carson City. He believes holding court in both the northern and southern parts of the state would cause many qualified candidates to seek the bench who now do not want to leave friends and acquaintances to establish a new home in another area.

Of the five judges currently on the court, Phillips noted that only one is from Las Vegas.

Concerning the selection of Supreme Court justices, he opposes a proposal to have an appointive system established. Phillips believes "the power to select and elect should remain

with the people."

Phillips also advocates bringing the Supreme Court "closer to the people" by initiating a program of regularly publishing summaries of court actions in local newspapers.

Phillips was a member of the Nevada Civil Rights Commission during 1960-62 and currently is a member of the American Bar Association, the American Arbitration Association, American Trial Lawyers Association, International Footprinters Association, Life Member of the United States Auto Club, Indianapolis, Indiana, and has been a member of the Musicians Union since 1945.
