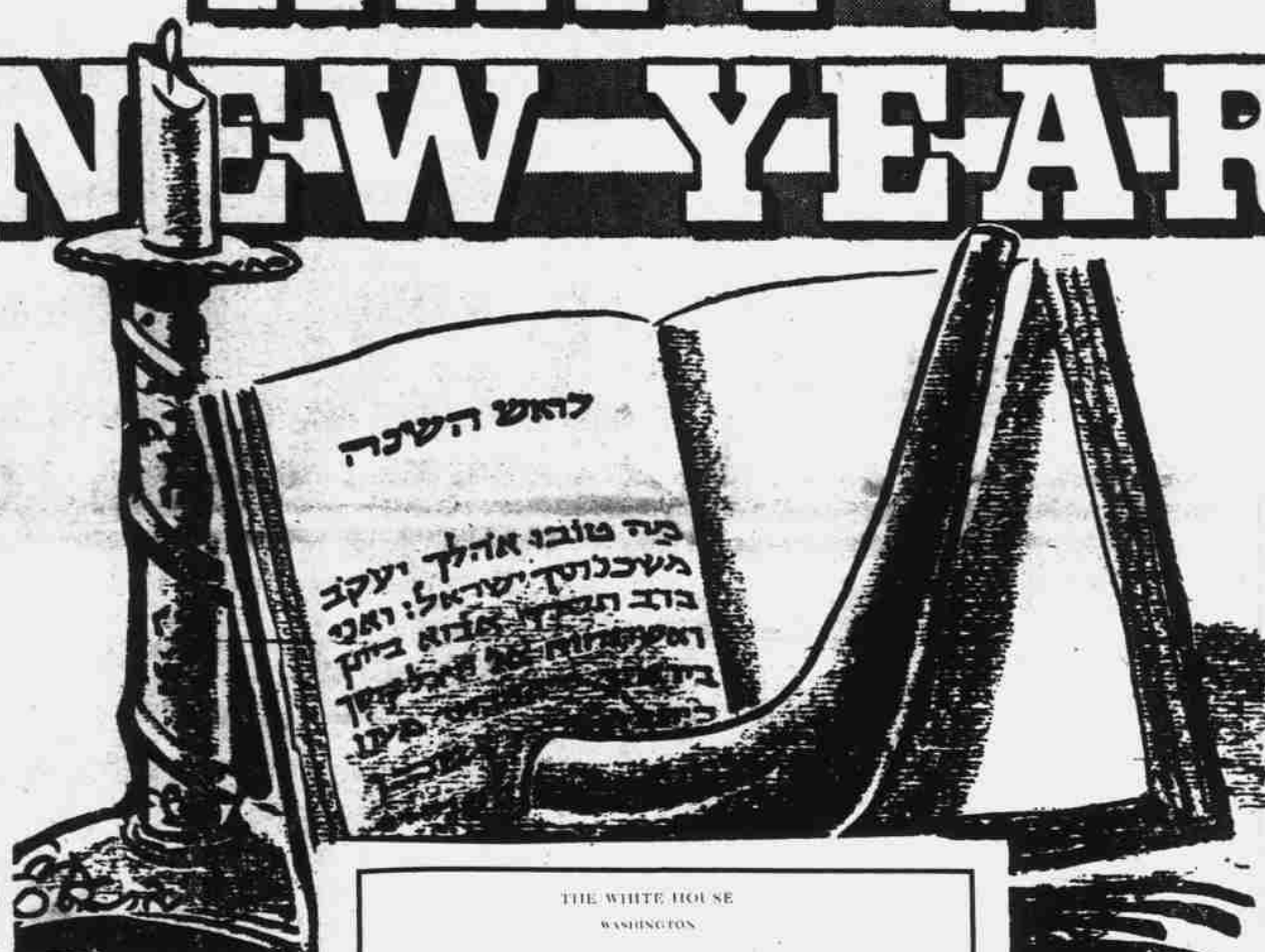

DEPLORE ELECTION APPEALS ON ISRAEL ISSUE

Eight major national
Jewish organizations
joined in deploring par-
tisan political appeals to
Jews based on the single
issue of U.S. support of
Israel.

Such appeals "st-
arting or suggesting
that the votes of all or
most Jews for parties
or candidates will or
should be determined by
this consideration alone
are a disservice to the
nation and to Jewish vot-
ers," the organizations
said in a statement.
