prayed through the centuries, the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, in association with other cooperating American Jewish groups, has created the American Committee for Israel's 25th Anniversary Cele-bration to coordinate the nationwide activities in the observance of the celebration.

This is appropriate because the American Jewish community played a most important role in the events leading up to the establish-ment of Israel, and since its founding has given Israel people great support. The birth of Israel has been a source of inspiration and gratification to American Jewry and has made a great contribution to our lives as American Jews. It has intensified our Jewish commitment, strengthened Jewish educational activities and deepened our spirtual ties.

The 25th Anniversary ceremonies, which will climax on May 6-7 of 1973, the actual date of the establishment of Israel, will commence with ceremonies later this month. The American Jewish community will assemble at the Synagogue at the John F. Kennedy Airport on Tuesday, Sept. 26th, along with Americans of all faiths, to participate in the lighting of a 25 candle Menorah from a Flame of Independence Torch wthat will be lit twodays earlier in Jerusalem by President Zalman Shazar.
