

Jewish Welfare Board Holiday Services for Vets

In Munich, where Adolf Hitler staged his first putsch, and in Augsburg, American Jewish servicemen will usher in the Jewish New Year through arrangements made possible by the National Jewish Welfare Board (JWB) it was announced by Rabbi Emanuel Rackman, Chairman of JWB's Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy, Chaplain (Capt.) Elliott M. Marmon, District

Jewish Chaplain of the Sued Bayern District, notes in a letter to JWB that Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year), which this year starts at sundown Friday, Sept. 8, and ends at sundown Sunday, Sept. 10, occurs during the last days of the summer Olympic Games.

The Munich and Augsburg services on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement), from sundown Sunday, Sept. 17, to sunset Monday Sept. 18, will be part of High Holy Day services conducted at more than 650 overseas and U.S. military installations, on Army transports and Navy vessels on the high seas, and at Veterans Administration hospitals.

Tons of kosher food, Torah scrolls, prayer books, prayer shawls, skull caps, ram's horns, Jewish calendars and inspirational literature were among the supplies sent by JWB for High Holy Day observances in Germany, Thailand, Vietnam, Japan, Okinawa, Greece, Panama, the Azores and all U.S. installations.

High Holy Day gifts and traditional Jewish foods were sent to the USO Clubs in Thailand for the Jewish men using those facilities during the holiday period.

At some military posts, leave is being granted to permit men to travel home for the holidays. A number of men will be offered home hospitality in local communities for the holidays.

JWB is the agency accredited by the U.S. Government to provide religious, morale and welfare services to Jews in the U.S. Armed Forces, their families and hospitalized Jewish veterans on behalf of the American Jewish community. It is a beneficiary of the United Jewish Appeal of Greater New York and of hundreds of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds throughout the country.
