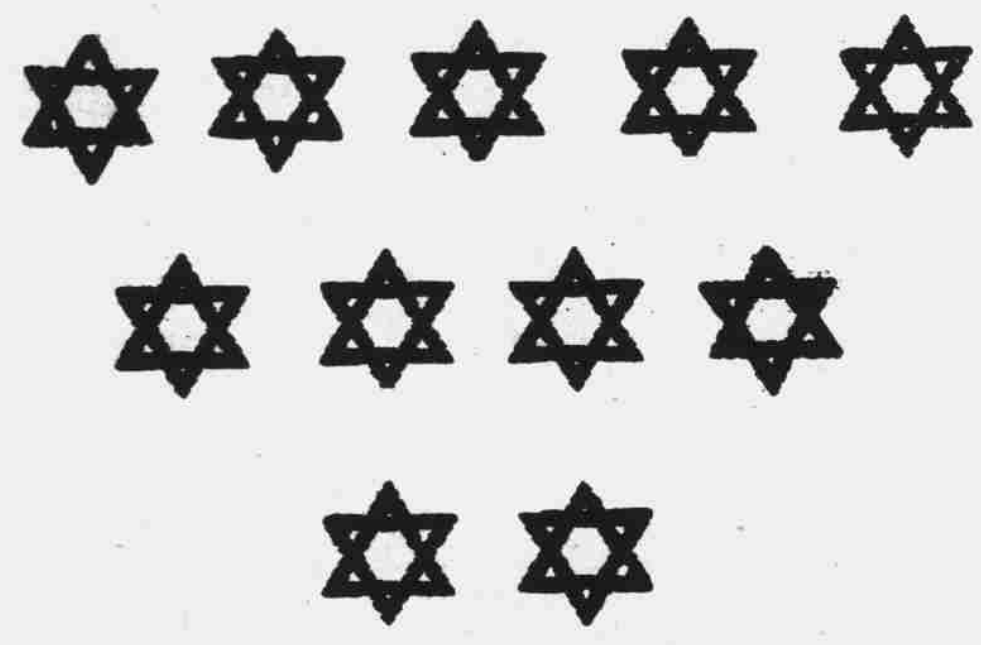
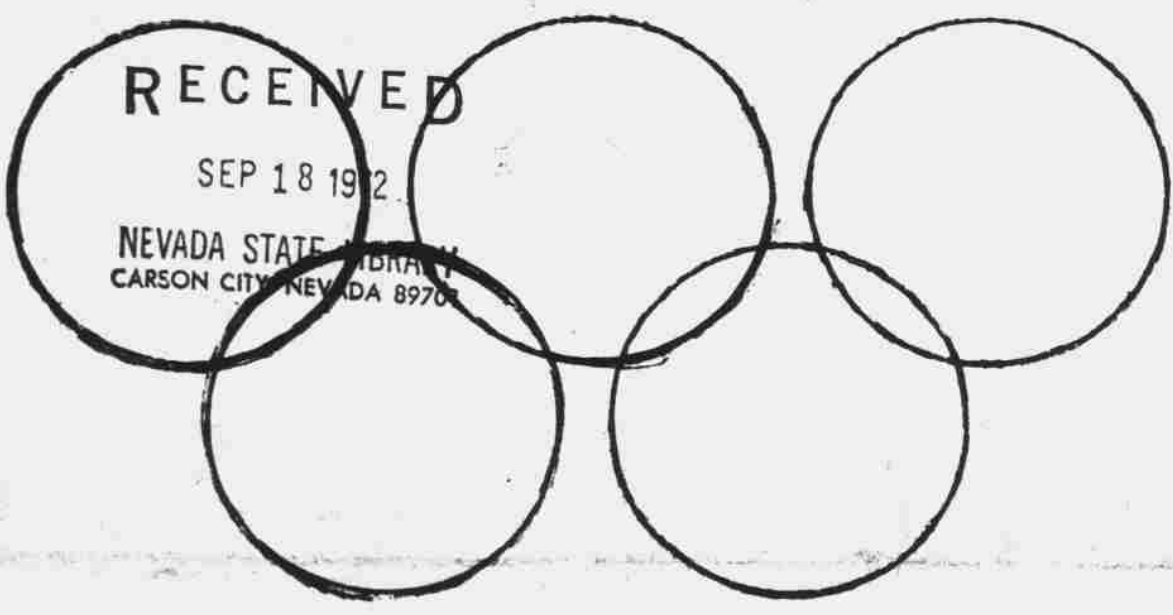

It Will Happen Again

It will happen again. It has been happening since 1948 when Israel became a nation, except for a short hiatus during and immediately after the 6-Day War in 1967. That is why it will happen again. TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Lod Airport was the scene of a solemn funeral service for the 11 killed Israeli Olympians. Israeli dignitaries, top military and sports figures, foreign envoys and diplomats & the families and friends of the victims were joined by thousands on the airfield Tarmac to witness the rites. Separate funeral ser-

vices were held for each of the 10 whose bodies were flown here from Munich. The remains of the 11th victim, American-born weightlifter David Berger, was flown from Munich to Cleveland, Ohio, at the request of his parents. The eleven killed were: Amitzur Shapira a coach; Andre Spitzer fencing coach; Jacob Spierling, a weight-lifting referee; Joseph Gutfreund, a wrestling referee Elizer Halfin, a wrestler; Mark Slavin a wr-

estler; David Berger, a weight-lifter; Zeev Friedman, a weight-lifter and Joseph Romano, a weight-lifter, and Moshe Weinberg, wrestling coach. Another was Kahat Shorr, a shooting trainer.
