

U.S. OFFICIALS CONDEMN MURDERS

WASHINGTON, D.C. (WNS) -- President Richard M. Nixon cabled Premier Golda Meir extending the sympathy of the American people for what he described as a "tragedy for all the people and all the nations of the world."

President Nixon also directed Secretary of State William P. Rogers to "consult other governments on an urgent basis as to what collective measures by the international community can be brought to bear on the problem of terrorism."

Later, the killing of the 11 Israeli athletes was assailed by the President as a "hideous perversion of the Olympic spirit" and a "senseless tragedy."

In Los Angeles, Senator George McGovern charged that two Arab governments, Egypt and Lebanon, shared responsibility for the "brutal wave of terrorism carried out by

international gangsters' to destroy the State of Israel.

And in the nation's capital, both houses of Congress adopted identical resolutions calling on the civilized world to ostracize nations and peoples who aid and abet such acts as the murder of 11 members of the Israeli Olympic Squad. The resolutions were adopted unanimously. Both chambers directed their resolutions be sent to Secretary of State Rogers for "appropriate transmittal."

EUROPE AGHAST AT BLOODBATH

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Europe was aghast at the bloodbath in Munich. From French President Georges Pompidou to Pope Paul VI to members of the Communist bloc --- all condemned the terrorist act.

Radio Budapest declared that "this act of

terrorism lowers the Palestinian movement to the level of political gangsterism."

Throughout New York and across the country memorial services were held. Flags were flown at half-mast.

In Munich itself, the huge Olympic stadium was the scene of grief and mourning as 80,000 persons from 120 nations gathered to pay homage to the slain Israelis.

Argentine, Uruguayan and Brazilian leaders joined the world-wide protest against the tragic killings.

ARAB STATES AID TERRORISTS

WASHINGTON, D.C. (WNS) -- Ambassador Yitzhak Rabin named "at least" six Arab countries which he claimed were aiding terrorist organizations that commit atrocities such as the murder of 11 members of the Israeli Olympic squad in Munich.

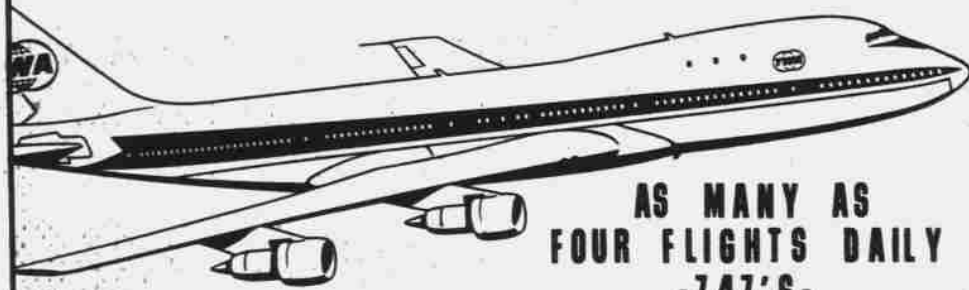
