NEW YORK -- Israel's Yad L' Achim, the non-partism organization that does yoeman work in assisting religious Russian immigrants, has responded to the increased tempo of immigration by expanding its efforts in this vitally crucial field.

BALTIMORE (WNS) -- Baltimore, Tucson, Arizona and Boston were among the three cities who have, in the past few days, participated in welcoming the arrival of the Torch of Independence, lit in Jerusalem by Israel's President Zalman Shazar.

WASHINGTON -- A campaign of encouraging their respective governments to support a UN Convention against terrorism is being initiated by its affiliates throughout the world, B'nai B'rith reported this week.
