## Keep Courts Clean

"We must keep our courts clean."

That statement was made by Alfred E. Smith in an unprecedented appearance of a Democrat before a New York State Republican nominating convention. It was not a request, It was a demand. The demand was granted, because Al Smith added, in a warning to the G.O.P. delegates: "If you do not join the Democrats in nominating Benjamin Cardozo to the state supreme court, don't look for any consideration from me in the next legislature.

Smith, at that time was speaker of the state assembly. He went on to serve four terms as Cardozo was elected on a fusion governor. ticket, rendered brilliant legal decisions and scored a monumental career as U.S. Supreme Court justice.
