## BOTH CLAIM JEWISH SUPPORT

NEW YORK (WNS) -- As the campaign makes its way toward election day, supporters of both the Democratic and Republican presidential nominees were predicting that the Jewish vote was solidly behind their respective candidates.

A spokesman for the McGovern - Shriver Campaign Committee in Washington said that although there was "no Jewish bloc vote," he predicted that Democratic presidential nominee McGovern would win more Jewish votes than Sen. Hubert

Humphrey did in 1968. Humphrey received about 80 percent of the Jews votes.

Meanwhile, at a press conference here, supporters of President Nixon predicted that he would double the Jewish vote this year, as compared with 1968. They claimed that the President had kept every promise he made to Israel.

Max Fisher of Detroit a Nixon supporter, told newsmen that the 1972 elections will be the first time Jews will vote on issues instead of

parties and that for the first time the issues for Jews were "sharply defined," Albert Spiegel of Los Angeles stated that McGovern was "negative" on Israel. He also claimed that there was "a great deal of concern" over McGovern's policy on quotas in college admissions and hiring.

McGovern supporters refuted the Nixon supporters' claims. Richard Cohen, staff director of the Jewish Affairs unit of the McGovern - Shriver Campaign Committee in Washington, said that "Jews have always tended to vote for can-

didates and parties that represented not special privilege but all the people, and I am confident they will in this election too." In reference to quotas, he said that while McGovern has spoken out against quotas as opposed to merit, it was the President's Department of Health, Education and Welfare that had ordered the City University in New York to require all faculty members to state their race, sex, and age on questionnaires as part of the affirmative action program.
