

JERUSALEM Chief Rabbi Shlomo Goren has sided with settlers of Kiryat Arba, Hebron's new Jewish quarter, who claim the Machpela Cave synagogue was vandalized, while police investiga-ting the case have indicated serious doubts that the synagogue on the site of the Patriarchs Tomb was broken into and that a damaged Torah scroll and torn prayer books actually came from the building.

Meanwhile, friction continued between Moslem and Jewish residents of the West Bank town. The Moslem Religious Council is opposing plans by the Mil-itary Government to enlarge the Jewish area of worship at the Machpela Cave, a shrine sacred to Moslems and Jews.

The Jewish settlers have written to Premier Golda Meir demanding their quarter be enlarged into a full-size all-Jewish city of 100,000 alongside the Arab city of 50,000.
