In Memorium

Out of the dirt comes food, fruit and foliage. Out of sorrow there sometimes emerges beauty.

The world is still stunned over the horror of the Munich murder of the Israeli II.

That tragedy elicited a cluster of statements which shine in spiritual loveliness.

The statements I refer to are those from Christians who were shocked by what happened and reacted with revulsion and with a new zeal for fraternalism.

In temple bulletin after temple bulletin I have read these statements, and they constitute an elegy of eulogy.

Someone should collect them -- and offer them as a literary bouquet on the graves of the martyred ones, and as evidence of the new spiritual brotherhood linking the various religious faiths of our world.

Grief also produced a cornucopia of tributes that would also make a tender tome.

I relay part of one such salute offered by Rabbi Cyrus Arfa of Brooklyn. Reprinting the Biblical cry of solace, "Comfort ye, comfort ye, my people," Rabbi Arfa goes on to say:

"The best way we can comfort the mourners in Zion is by taking an added measure of responsibility. The prayers the fallen athletes might have offered we must offer. The books they might have created and read, we must create and read. The Shabbat candles they would have helped to kindle, we must kindle. The charity they would have given we must give. The strength they would have given to Israel we must give. The dignity they have given by their lifestyle, we must emulate. The love they had for the land of Israel we must have."

And the rabbi concludes this moving litany, thus: "The hope for peace they had we must work for."

Beautiful, no?
