

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Jewish National Fund spokesman says much of the criticism of its operations contained in the recently published report of the Zionist General Council's (Action Committee) Comptroller was inaccurate and misleading.

OTTAWA (WNS) -- A second financial agreement with the Export Development Corporation of Canada, providing for long-term credits amounting to \$25.6 million to the Israel Electric Corporation for Eshkol C and D thermal power stations in Ashdod was signed here.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Pennsylvania's two Senators, Hugh Scott and Richard S. Schweiker, and eight Philadelphia area Representatives have urged President Nixon to intervene personally on behalf of Jews in Iraq and Syria.

NEW YORK -- The Zionist Organization of America announced establishment of a permanent scholarship at its Kfar Silver Agricultural High School in Israel in honor of Sen. Henry M. Jackson of Washington.

NEW YORK -- Rep. Mario Biaggi of New York City said he was "horrified and angered" at reports of new executions of Iraqi Jews and called on the United Nations and the United States to immediately file official protests and apply sanctions against Iraq.

WASHINGTON, D. C. -- Japan Air Lines has adopted a public relations program to mask its continuing participation in the Arab economic boycott of Israel, the Jewish War Veterans of the U. S. A. charged.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Israeli Finance Minister Pinhas Sapir met with Treasury Secretary George Schultz to discuss Israel's general problems stemming from the devaluation of the dollar and whether "something can be done with the help of the United States government."

5 MORE IRAQI JEWS JAILED

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Five more Iraqi Jews -- a woman and four men -- were recently arrested in Iraq according to reports reaching student organizations here.

The student spokesman said the latest arrests indicate a new wave of persecution directed against Iraq's remaining small Jewish community.

Earlier this week in Paris, more than 100 French parliamentarians, Senators and National Assembly members asked Syria and Iraq to "stop persecuting their Jews."
