ROUND TOWN.....The newest edition of "Casino de Paris" (which is even newer than the 1973 edition that opened about eight weeks ago) has, after major alterations too numerous to mention, taken its rightful place as one of the "don't miss" spectaculars on the Strip. Everything is better than it was two short months ago; what a difference!! KITTY KOVER is the new star; a sexy, seasoned singer-dancer, Kitty's tribute to Al Jolson is just fine but it's her terrific outing with six male dancers called "Resurrection Shuffle" that'll stay with showgoers. The most exciting act on the Strip has to be THE ARGENTINIAN GAUCHOS – their daring bolo dance inches from the ringsiders is breathtaking and chilling. The Gauchos, who have appeared here with "Latin Fire Follies", are finally getting the star showcasing they deserve. In addition to their bolo dance, The Gauchos do a drum dance, a sword dance and a spirited Argentinian folk number. THE DOUBLE THREE SINGERS are in and out of production numbers and have two solo spots of their own. The Double Three are really three individually featured singers and well they should be. All are known here for their solo outings: ANN SYDNEY ("Let's Make Love"), GINNIE PALLONE ("Tower Sweets Revue", "Bare Touch of Vegas", etc.) and BARRY MONROE ("Vive Les Girls", "Pzazz", "Let's Make Love" and his single bow at the Desert Inn). PAUL & FERDINAND FERCO do double duty first as the dizzying juggling act called LES QUATRE TONYS and later in a stunning acrobatic ensemble called THE FLYING FERCOS. Also featured in the new spectacle produced by FREDERIC "APCAR, staged and choreographed by RON LEWIS, are lead nude dancer VIRGINIA OLMEDO, and sight comedy duo LES DEUX KIMS. The company also features some twenty eight Casino de Paris dancers and fourteen

Producers BARRY ASHTON & WOLF KOCHMANN ("Wonderful World of Burlesque", "Vie Parisienne", "Revue Royal de Paris" among their most current productions) will premiere their mostly new "THIS IS BURLESQUE" opus at the Aladdin's Bagdad Theater on April 5. As scheduled so far, "This is.." will star many of the cast of "Wonderful World" (which will close its five year run at the Silver Slipper on April 1) including IRV BENSON, MARILYN ROBERTSON, MISS VELVET, LISA & SALERNO, plus the addition of several dancers and showgirls and all new scenery, costumes, and production numbers, added to the show. Ashton, incidentally, still has the best and most lavish "New Faces"showcase production show still to be signed to a Strip hotel, Barry's recently closed N.Y. Americana Hotel revue, "CATCH A RISING STAR" would make an ideal Strip attraction using six production numbers and featuring three or four changing new talents. New talent abounds in wild abundance 'round Las Vegas; the stars of tomorrow are here today if they are given a chance, a place and a vehicle in which to display their gifts!!.....
