Asked at a press -conference in Moscow if Brezhnev had reflected any willingness to rescind the Soviet education tax, Shultz replied "that it is a question they will have to an-swer," and declined to offer any details of the Soviet authorities response.

Shultz said he explained the Soviet Jewish issue from the Washington standpoint as clearly as he could to Brezhnev, but emphasized that President Nison had not sent him to Moscow to negotiate any agreement between the two governments. Rather, he said, he came to Moscow to review the. possibilities of developing Soviet - American trade and economical relations. He said he was optimistic of the future of Soviet-American trade and that during his talks he had found desires to solve problems between the superpowers.
