

TO RESETTLE SOVIET JEWS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The United States was to make \$31 million available for the resettlement of Soviet Jewish emigrants to Israel. The funds, part of the \$50 million appropriated by Congress for Soviet emigrants regardless of religious background, will be turned over to the United States Appeal which will then transfer them to the Jewish Agency. Of the \$31 million, \$25 million will be used to enlarge the transit area near Vienna where most of the Soviet Jewish emigrants arrive. The remainder is to be used for building a hospital wing, housing, and for Hebrew language training and education of the refugees in Israel.

JOBS FOR COLLEGE GRADS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Education and Culture Minister Yigal Alon told a Hebrew University Board of Governors meeting that Israeli universities must engage in more planning

to assure graduates of jobs, though it is "very unlikely" that any large number of graduates will find themselves without jobs in the near future.

Absorption Minister Natan Peled told the Knesset that college graduates arriving in Israel must be able to find jobs in their fields if the prospects for large scale immigration are not to diminish. He noted that many white collar professions will soon be saturated and that a number of potential immigrants from the West had decided recently against coming after learning that no suitable jobs were available for them.

Peled disclosed that 25,000 out of 200,000 immigrants who arrived in Israel after the Six-Day-War have since left.

HAPPY PASSOVER

BILLY GRAHAM EASES CONCERN OVER KEY 73

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Rabbi Marc H. Tanenbaum, director of interreligious affairs of the American Jewish Committee welcomed as "a constructive contribution to interreligious understanding" evangelist Billy Graham's statement, regarding Jewish concerns over the Key 73 Campaign, that he opposed "all forms of coercion, intimidation and proselytizing."

Rabbi Tanenbaum expressed confidence the statement would encourage other Christian leaders to "make clear that Key 73 is aimed at teaching uncommitted Christians

and has no intention of proselytizing the Jewish community."

Rabbi Tanenbaum made public a 36-page AJ Committee survey that detailed a variety of episodes of psychological harassment, deception and intimidation. He said that national dialogue over Key 73 might result in the emergence of a majority consensus of Christian leaders declaring, for the first time in the history of Jewish-Christian relations in the U. S., a policy of opposition to proselytizing the Jewish community.
