DISCOUNTE UNITED NATIONS. -- The Israeli (WNS) Missionhas rejected as "transparent and primitive lies" a denial by the Iraqi UN Mission that some Iraqi lews have been imprisoned or executed.

The Iraqi statement attributed the reported executions to "the Zionist propaganda mach-ine" which it said was circulating "falsehood and fabrication in an attempt to discredit the government of Iraq." The statement, the first denial by an official source, claimed that a "thorough investigation has revealed" that most of the Iraqi Jews reported imprisoned or executed while in prison "had in fact illegally departed from Iraq," and that "unofficial reports" indicated that some have been seen in the U. S. The Israeli Mission called the statement "sheer moc-

Even while this denial was being circulated reports arrrived from Jerusalem that two more Iraqi Jews have disappeared and that the Israel Student Union feared for their lives. They were identified as Naji and Surad Kashboush.
