**CANNON MEETS SOVIET JEWS**

SAN FRANCISCO (WNS)-Sen. Howard W. Cannon took the initiative of contacting five Moscow Jews after a meeting with Soviet Communist Party chief Leonid Brezhnev and indicated he was surprised by what they told him of the situation of Jews in Russia because

it was at variance with what he and six other Senators were told by Brezhnev.

The Bay Area Council for Soviet Jewry had learned this information in a telephone conversation with Jewish sources in Moscow.

their posts and refused exit visas to leave the USSR, reportedly told Cannon the education tax, which Soviet leaders say has been suspended, is only one ob-

stacle to emigration. They said, for example, that Soviet authorities claim they cannot be permitted to leave because they had been exposed to State secrets.

**ISRAEL INVESTIGATES IRAQI MURDERS**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The government announced it would raise the issue of renewed Iraqi persecution of Jewish families at a Knesset session.

Foreign Minister Abba Eban said reports he received "confirmed the very strong probability that there have been murders in Baghdad and kidnappings and disappearances as well."

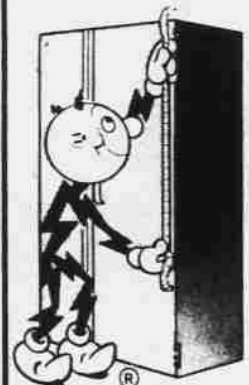
The Israel News Agency, ITIM, reported that five members of a Jewish family were shot to death by Iraqi secret service men. Two older boys from the same family were kidnapped several months ago, and are presumed to have been killed. During the past year 16 Jews have disappeared, but Iraqi authorities claim they fled to Iran.

The American Jewish committee reported that, according to information reaching its Paris office, two more Jews were recently murdered in Baghdad. They were identified only as Dr. Violet Toeg and her husband.
