The announcement of the trip said Lindsay would "take up the issue of Soviet Jewry with Soviet officials and private citizens, including members of the Jewish community."

In a separate statement, issued jointly by Maass, Stein and Fisher, the three leaders welcomed the suspension of the education tax and acknowledged "with appreciation the initiative of President Nixon in this achievement."

MIDEAST CRISIS NIXON'S HIGHEST PRIORITY

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- President Nixon said the Middle East has higher priority than any other world crisis for the United States. But his 232-page annual foreign policy report did not indicate specific progress or fresh initiatives toward settlement of the Arab-Israeli conflict during the past year, either toward an interim agreement, initiated by the U. S., or an overall settlement as sought by the United Nations in its mandate to Ambassador Gunnar V. Jarring.

NEW 5 YEAR PLAN

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Calling for an expanded economy to meet the needs of 65,000 new immigrants yearly, Finance Minister Pinhas Sapir introduced a new national economic plan in the Cabinet covering the five-year period up to 1978.

The plan, to be debated by the Ministerial Economic Committee, calls for an average yearly gross national

product of 7.8 per cent and an average annual increase of 4.5 per cent in productivity.

According to the projection, exports are to increase at an annual rate of 5.8 percent, and imports by 8 percent.
