LV COMMISSIONER HANK THORNLEY DEFIED 2-FACED HANK GREENSPUN

ONLY MIDEAST SOLUTION DIALOGUE

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Israeli Foreign Minister Abba Eban said that a dialogue between the Arabs and Israel was the only way to solve the Mideast conflict, and expressed hope that the spirit of dialogue, which has succeeded in interminating conflicts in other areas of the world or has developed new relationships between countries, will also prevail in the Middle East.

"Triumph comes as a result of direct contacts," not by imposed settlements. He noted that while "progress has been slow" it has "been perceptible. The Arab world has begun to awaken to the hopelessness of the military dream."

Referring to the UN's role in the Middle East, Eban said it "has not become an arena for solving conflicts but an

arena for waging them." Israel, he continued, is aware that she will have to compromise.

In Montreal where Eban came to address a State of Israel Bonds man-of-the-year dinner, the Foreign Minister told newsmen that Palestinian terrorists have no influence whatsoever on Israel or on the majority of Arabs in the administered territories, warned that the projected union between Libya and Egypt could aggravate the Middle East conflict and maintained that "nothing has changed" in U. S. policy toward Israel despite Arab oil politics. He also met with Canadian Foreign Secretary Mitchell Sharp. Eban said the present demarcation lines "are not sacrosanct" and that Israel is not following a policy of "arbitrary annexation", but that he saw no reason why Israelis should not live-

Greenspun's Complaint

As we were going to press, there was mention in the Watergate hearings of a break-in of Hank Greenspun's safe in his Las Vegas office.

Greenspun, who never misses a crack at publicity, called a press conference and theorized the real reason for the attempted safe-cracking was to get some original Howard Hughes' memos, which Greenspun says were damaging to the billionaire.

Let's analyze this. There is documented proof that Greenspun laiched on to about \$10,000,000 of Hughes' money under strange and most suspicious circumstances. One was a \$4,000,000 cash loan seven years ago, on which not a single payment has been made to date. The terms of 3% interest were such, the Wall Street Journal stated, could not be obtained by General Motors from the Bank of America. The note was never filed until Hughes' auditors went over the books three years later after Bob Maheu was dismissed.

Another item was an advance of half a million in cash for future advertising, for years ignored by Greenspun until, again, auditors found it in the Hughes' books.

Then there is the multi-million dollar golf course deal, which Hughes is contesting in court. So, what is Greenspun attempting to imply by the damaging memos he says he has?

Is Greenspun contending Hughes owes him money?

Ever hear of the con-man blaming the sucker?

The City Elections

In these precipitous days for any office holder, with corruption, bribery and chicanery running rampant, it is about time we looked beyond the man on the dock and reject the man responsible for the state of decadence that has enveloped all levels of our government.

The most powerful political boss in Nevada, with tentacles clawing every facet of the offices that rule our destinies, is Sun publisher Hank Greenspun.

In return for his endorsement Greenspun demands the high price of strict subservience to his dictates. In the guise of being a public benefactor, he will use threats and pressure to gain his own selfish ends, and woe betide anyone who dares defy his will.

Commissioner Hank Thornley refused to be intimidated by Greenspun, and therefore is the target of the publisher's venom in the upcoming City elections on June 5.

If we are ever to break Greenspun's stranglehold, let us start by careful consideration of the circumstances surrounding the City commissioner's race and determine the greed, the inordinate desire for power and wealth, and the ruthlessness of the man who is backing Thornley's opponent, Paul Christensen.

Christensen is a first-time public office seeker, with no record, good or bad, in his background. During his campaign in the primaries he advanced not one single issue. We do not flaw his reputation. But politics make strange bedfellows. Christensen's night-gown companion (literally speaking) is Hank Greenspun, who front-paged a devastating editorial against Thornley on the Sunday before Tuesday's primary election. Here's why.

A supermarket chain was seeking renewal of a slot machine license. Greenspun had a two-fold purpose in supporting the renewal. First, there is a \$50,000-a-year existing commitment for advertising, and second, there was talk of the chain opening a branch in a proposed shopping center owned by Greenspun.

Thornley was one of three commissioners of the five-man commission who had voted against the renewal of the license. Greenspun was adamant with threats and pressure to get Thornley's vote. At one stage an apparent friend warned that Thornley would be accused, by a story in the Sun, of asking for \$25,000 in return for his consent. The story would appear, it was threatened, if Thornley did not vote in the affirmative for the license. The ISRAELITE exposed the plot to assassinate Thornley's character, and nothing ever happened. But Greenspun never forgot.

MRS. MEIR WARNS EGYPT

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Premier Golda Meir warned Egypt that if it renewed hostilities against Israel it could expect dire consequences. It was her second public warning to Egypt in little more than a week.

Israeli leaders apparently believe that Egyptian President Anwar Sadat has not abandoned his intention of a military move in the near future, and may launch an attack during the Nixon - Brezhnev summit talks in Washington which start June 18 or while the United Nations Security Council is holding its Middle East debate -- which Egypt requested -- late this month or in early June.
