DAYAN URGES RETALIATION

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Col. Yosef Alon, the 43-year-old Air Attache at the Israel Embassy in Washington who was murdered outside his home in Suburban Bethesda, MD., was buried here in a military funeral. His body was returned to Israel in a U. S. Air Force jet accompanied by his wife and three daughters.

Defense Minister Moshe Dayan, who eulogized the slain diplomat and Air Force pilot, repeated his warning that Israel will strike back at terrorists

and countries that shield them or supply them with funds. Dayan earlier urged other governments to do everything possible to prevent further such murders.

In Washington, neither the FBI nor the Montgomery County, MD., police have come up with evidence yet that the crime was politically motivated. The FBI said all possibilities are being checked including political motivation, street crime and personal grudges.

Whuh

Much to nobody's surprise, at least not to those who have been reading the LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE the past three years, it has been disclosed the past week that the IRS is putting the bite on Sun Publisher Hank Greenspun for income tax deficiency to the tune of from \$1,600,000 to \$2 million plus.

You don't have to be a Harvard professor or a Philadelphia lawyer to know this story was about to break. Any horse player, able to read the past performances in the Racing Form, could have figured from the circumstances of the past few weeks that Greenspun had imminent problems with the IRS. Otherwise, why would he blast the federal agency in column after column? And why, in what appeared to be a desperate last gesture, would he spend an entire interview on a Los Angeles local TV program releasing pent-up wrath denouncing the IRS and Howard Hughes? That was the tip-off Greenspun was in trouble.

We do not gloat over Greenspun's, or for that matter anyone's, tangle with the federal revenue-ers. They are despotic, mean, harsh and cruel against any soul unfortunate to be caught in their mesh.

We do not know whether Greenspun will be able to beat this rap. He has declared all out war against the IRS. He has vowed to investigate those who have been investigating him. While we hope he will be able to expose the contemptible tactics employed by the agency, to bring some relief to otherwise innocent victims under continual harassment, we cannot sympathize too much with the plight of the Sun publisher. Greenspun is, and always has been strictly for Greenspun.

It was that way when he took out after the insurance companies, because of his own involvement when the old Sun building burned down about 10 years ago. You all know what he did to Howard Hughes, after Hughes' money made him a millionaire. Now its the IRS.

Surely the Sun publisher must have been aware of so many of his readers, who for years have been harassed unmercifully by the same IRS. It is only when he becomes personally involved that he does something about it.

The man has very little visible regard for his responsibility as a newspaper publisher. He's ambitious, for which we give him all credit. But he uses his power to grab everything in sight - for personal gain.

His big break came when he was able to latch on to large sums of money from Hughes unusual deals via Robert Maheu. Then he elected Mike O'Callaghan to the governor's seat.

PLIGHT OF IRAQI JEWS WORSENING

NEW YORK (WNS) --
Two Jewish refugees

from Iraq told a press conference that conditions for the 350 Jews still in Baghdad were worsening and that the only way to aid Iraqi government.

One of the refugees, Mrs. Adile Dalal, 38, the widow of a Jew hanged in Baghdad four years ago, charged that Jews in Iraq continue to be murdered, kidnapped and tortured.

Mrs. Dalal, who escaped from Iraq a few months ago, was accompanied at the press conference, by a young man in his 20's who said he was spirited out of the country by a professional smuggler who charged him \$500. The young man, who used a pseudonym to protect his family still in Iraq said that 18 members of his family disappeared a few months ago from Baghdad and their fate is still unknown.
