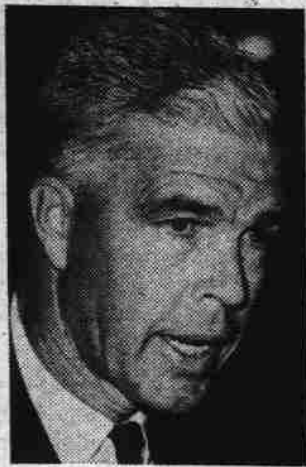


**TO ADDRESS HADASSAH CONVENTION AUGUST 26-29**

A broad array of speakers representing its multi-faceted interests, will address Hadassah's 59th annual national convention at the Denver Hilton Hotel August 26-29. Speakers include: Israel ambassador to US, Simcha Dinitz; Senator Peter Dominick (R. Col.); Fred W. Friendly, Ford Foundation advisor on TV and Public Broadcasting; Dr. Carl A. Hoffman, immediate past president of the American Medical Association and an authority on health services around the world; Joseph Klarman, of Israel, World Director of Youth Aliyah; Harvard Professor J. Kenneth Galbraith, economist, and former Ambassador to India. Over 2,500 delegates from 1,400 chapters and groups representing 325,000 members from all states, including Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico will hear speakers, attend workshops on health, education, youth, Zionist and American affairs, and fundraising. Hadassah, the largest women's organization in the world, maintains a network of medical, educational and rehabilitative services in Israel and sponsors youth, education and community volunteer programs in the US. It was founded by Henrietta Szold in 1912.

**LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE SENATORS CLASH OVER RED TRADE**

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Senators Henry M. Jackson (D. Wash.) and J. William Fulbright (D. Ark.) exchanged bitter attacks on each other over Jackson's amendment to withhold most-favored nation trade status from the Soviet Union unless it permitted free emigration of Jews and others. Fulbright, chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, said the Jackson Amendment aimed at a renewal of the cold war and that for the Soviet Union and the US to learn to live with each other is "too important to be compromised by meddling -- even idealistic meddling -- in each others affairs." Fulbright's remarks were made at a speech to the American Bankers Association.

Jackson, replying to him on television, said that Fulbright, along with Soviet Communist Party Secretary Leonid I. Brezhnev, was the leading advocate "of one way deals with Russia, we give and they take." He said he wanted genuine cooperation which was based on the easing of tensions and the free movement of people and ideas across borders.

Fulbright charged that Jackson was being

selective in his idealism and did not include the right to return to a country which he said is "invoked by the displaced Palestinians who are denied repatriation to their former homes

within the territory of Israel." However, Fulbright noted that the Russians are bending to the Jackson Amendment because of their desire for trade and are allowing more Jews to leave.
