Mideast at the end of August. Scali said if the resolution had been adopted it would have jeopardized Waldheim's mission since he would not have been accepted in Jerusalem. Tekoah had warned the Council that if they adopted the resolution it would have made Waldheim's trip futile.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Foreign Ministry has officially welcomed the U.S. veto of what it called "the unbalanced and unjust" resolution at the Security Council. The draft resolution which was supported by 13 of the 15 Council members would have deplored Israel's occupation of the territories taken in 1967.

The Foreign Ministry spokesman here said the U.S. action "prevented a serious blow at peace prospects in the Middle East." He said United Nations Secretary General Kurt Waldheim will now be able to come to the Middle East next month "without unnecessary obstacles." The spokesman said the Council vote also proved that the Mideast conflict cannot be solved at international forums and declared, "It is to be hoped that Egypt, which initiated this sterile debate, will now study the need for negotiations."

Israeli diplomats in several of the Council-member states, including Britain and France, are now expected to register Israel's displeasure at their support of an anti-Israeli resolution.

SOVIET JEWISH EMIGRATION DECLINES

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Soviet Jewish emigration to Israel during June and July dropped to approximately 1,000 to 1,200 per month compared with an average of more than 2,500 per month during the same period last year, according to the Union of Councils for Soviet Jews.

Harold B. Light of San Francisco, the Union's first vice-chairman, said most of the emigrants come from Georgia, Tbilisi and other areas far from the major Soviet cities. Light added that in Leningrad most of the 73 Jews officially notified that they will not be allowed to leave are intellectuals or activists for emigration.

In Israel, Absorption Minister Natan Peled told the Knesset that 14,370 Soviet Jews im-


migrated to Israel between January and June, about 1,000 fewer than the same period last year. He said the June figure was the lowest of the six months and the only time it dropped below 2,000.

Meanwhile, Fabian Kolker, of Baltimore, a member of the plenum of the National Conference of Soviet Jewry, reported that some 1,000 individuals on the list of Soviet Jews which Dr. Henry Kissinger, President Nixon's national security advisor, took with him to Moscow last May, only 58 have received exit visas and only 2/3 of them have left the Soviet Union. Kolker said the reasons the others did not leave was that not all members of their family -- in most cases children -- were permitted to emigrate with them.

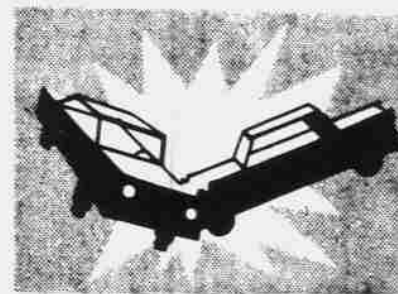

DAYAN FOR JEWS IN TERRITORIES

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Defense Minister Moshe Dayan, in a speech to his colleagues in the ex-Rafi section of the Labor Party, warned he might not remain on the Labor list for the October elections unless a clear program for action in the administered territories is adopted. Dayan said he could not support the "do-

nothing views" of Mapam and Finance Minister Pinhas Sapir. Urging that the Jewish dynamic be given full reign in the territories, Dayan said if Jewish settlement was barred there "we remove the unique element in this Zionist effort" of resettling the Jewish homeland.
