## STANDARD OIL COPS WEAK PLEA BUT THREATS OF JEWISH BOYCOTT MOUNT

### ASK NIXON SPEED SOVIET RELEASES

VIENNA (WNS) -- Rep. Ogden R. Reid (D. N.Y.) said on a visit here that the Nixon Administration should do more to speed up the emigration of Soviet Jews to Israel.

He said "top level talks between the U.S. and the Soviet Union have produced no progress in the question of Jewish emigration from Russia so far."

Reid, a U.S. Ambassador to Israel during the Eisenhower administration, was on his way

to Israel for an eight-day fact-finding tour.

Earlier in New York, Richard Maas, chairman of the National Conference on Soviet Jewry, said in a radio interview that the Soviet Union has cut back by seven percent last year's emigration of Jews to Israel and it may eventually be less than 15 percent.

He said from 400,000-500,000 Jews would emigrate if given the opportunity while some two million Soviet Jews would stay.

### NAZI MURDERESS IN BONN COURT

BONN (WNS) -- Mrs. Hermine Braunsteiner Ryan, who has been accused of helping select Jews for mass murder at the Lublin-Maidanek concentration camp during World War II, was secretly spirited out of the U.S. after Secretary

of State William P. Rogers signed an extradition warrant.

She is now waiting to be examined by a Dueseldorf Magistrate on charges of having sent 2000 Jewish women and children to the gas chambers, having killed a woman prisoner and helped in the hanging of a Jewish girl.

The 54-year-old Queens housewife was discovered living in the U.S.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Denunciations of Standard Oil of California continued and threats of boycott mounted by Jewish organizations despite an explanation by the company's board chairman Otto N. Miller that US efforts to bring peace in the Middle East should be based on "the legitimate interests of Israel and its people as well as the interests of all other states in the area."

Miller in a letter to stockholders and employees of SOCAL urged more positive support by US for "the aspirations of the Arab people." Following the denunciation by Jewish groups, he wrote a letter to Richard M. Kaplan, president of the Jewish Community Relations Council of San Francisco, saying that his essential point "was that a peace agreement fair and equitable to all states in the area, consistent with their independence and sovereign integrity, is essential to the United States."

Meanwhile The American Zionist Federation has submitted a memorandum to Jewish and Zionist community leaders across the nation urging them to write protest letters to Miller and returning their Chevron credit cards to SOCAL. A boycott was recommended by the Jewish War Veterans at its 78th annual convention in Hollywood, Florida, Rabbi Joseph B. Glazer, executive vice president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, also urged a boycott to the members of the Reform group.

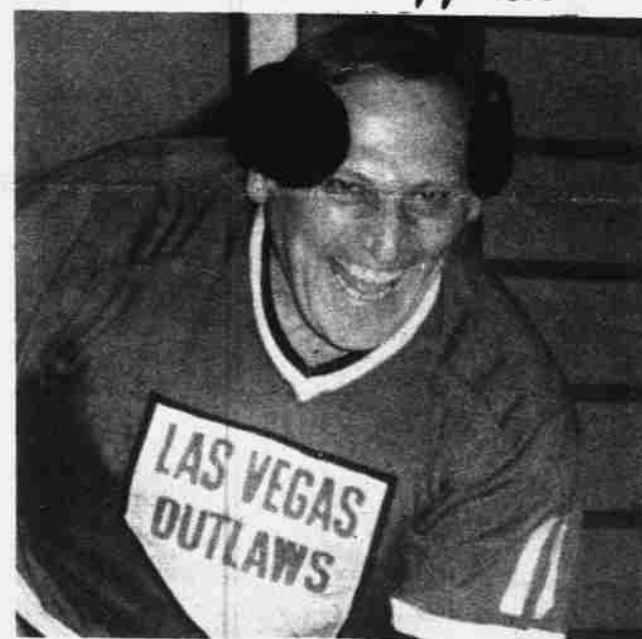
