**SOVIET JEWS' FATE JEWISH COMMUNITY CENTER NEWS**

**STILL SERIOUS**

**NEW YORK (WNS) --** Nicholas Scopetta, the city's commissioner of investigations, returned from trip to the Soviet Union and said that he found that certain Jewish scientists and others who wish to emigrate have been subject to loss of jobs, police surveillance and harassment and even imprisonment for minor infractions.

Meanwhile Rep. Thomas M. Ress (D. Ca.) has sent a telegram to top Soviet leaders and President Nixon urging the release of Soviet astrophysicist Evgeny Levich from the Soviet Army because of his serious health problems and requesting that he be allowed to emigrate with his family to Israel.
