

\$600 and a Mule" should make about \$1 Million and A Drama Critics Award by the time they're through in Los Angeles. delightful history of black music from Africa to today, "\$600" is a dream of musical. The dancing, and hallelujah, there's plenty of that, is nothing short of sensational. Never have I seen so many fine dancers on one stage with a special kudo to MICHELE SIMMONS & MICH-AEL PETERS for their sensitive "Angels" number although I would hardly call ANGEL DAVIS an angel. That's what they call dramatic license.

An out of sight ballet, "Sniff Me, Snort Me" about the evils of hard dope is a real trip with the gorgeous MYRNA WHITE (who seems to light up the whole Huntington Hartford stage when she merely smiles) as the super evil pusher. WINSTON DEWITT HEMS-LEY, a favorite of mine from "Don't Bother Me, I Can't Cope." does a double whammy with his "Lighted Candles" and then a perfect SAMMY DAVIS impresh.

TRINA PARKS IS BESSIE SMITH, LESTER WILSON (who also conceived, directed and choreographed) has a strong voice, PETER COLLY knocked the audience out with "Good Morning. Mr, Sun" and the rest of the cast, PRUDENCE DARBY, LORRAINE FIELDS, ANDREA HAIRS TON, GERRI REDDICK, ARLENE ROLANT, GARY CHAPMAN, BRUCE HEATH, REGGIE JACKSON, ARTHUR SMALLS, JR. & ERAN SMITH, well, they are all first rate. Costumes by ANDREA LILLY are smashing, lighting by KEN BILLINGTON is top drawer, in other words, "\$600 and a Mule" is one helluva show. SAMMY DAVIS invited us over to the Mar-

Jews over their second class citizenship.

Isolation and alienation are the twin problems that face Israel, problems that many Israeli leaders refuse to deal with and in "stiff-necked" fashion reject as real problems.


Israeli leaders point to the United States as its only real friend. This is in itself a tragic commentary because the U.S. is as, if not more, isolated in the world arena. Many countries, especially in Central and South America, that felt a genuine kinship toward Israel and the Jews as a people and a nation which made good espite great odds, are beginning to cool toward Israel because of its unswerving loyalty to the U.S. Government and its uncritical acceptance of American Foreign policy.

At the same time, more and more Jews young and old - including committed Zionists, feel that Israel's attachment to the U.S., its internal policies toward the Sephardic Jews, its militant opposition to such Israel-Palestinian peaceniks as Arye Eliav and Yitzhak Ben Aharon, the increasing disparity between the affluent i.w and the impoverished many, the insensivity of the bureacracy toward olim, and the disdain expressed by many Israeli leaders toward diaspora Jewry, is a contradiction of the very reason for Israel's existence.

These criticisms are expressed at Zionist congresses and was underlined at the latest World Jewish Congress and the Israel-American Dialogue convention in Jerusalem by such responsible leaders as Dr. Joachim Prinz and Rabbi Arthur Herzberg. These and other critics cannot be dismissed as a few disgruntled individuals, especially since they are among the staunchest opponents of the anti-Israel anti-Zionist views espoused by the Soviet-Chinese-Arab-Third World bloc.

In the world of realpolitik governments are important, and Israel has no choice but to relate to existing governments. But governments come and go and friendly ones are re-placed by hostile ones or the reverse. But the Jewish people are the only lasting friends that Israel can count on.

If the young Jews of today -- tomorrow's leaders -- are estranged and disillusioned, where will be the Jews of the future who will bend every will and effort to protect and support Israel? This situation ought to receive much thought as Jews enter the year 5733. Above all, Jews in Israel and throughout the diaspora would do well to ponder Israeli President Ephraim Katzirs admonition to "return to raising the socialistic, human and practical values of the human race.
