# Women for Minyan

After 5734 years, our Jewish religion, at least the Conservative branch of it, decided that women may take their places alongside the traditional role reserved only for men, as members of a minyan.

No sooner, after the news was released by the Rabbinical Assembly and appeared on the front page of the New York Times, objectors and those who agreed, voiced their views.

Orthodox groups, the world over, criticized the innovations. But American Jewish Congress and National Jewish women's groups, naturally approved.

It is interesting to note that some local women we informed of the break with tradition, were not too over-enthusiastic. Be that as it is, here are the ramifications:
